


The Book of Genesis, 232

"...only four life spans link together the continuity of tradition from Adam to Jacob, and these make three links. The four life spans are Adam, Lamech, Shem and Jacob. The three links are from Adam to Lamech, since Adam was living when Lamech was born; from Lamech to Shem, since Lamech was living when Shem was born; and from Shem to Isaac and Jacob, since Shem was still living when both Isaac and Jacob were born. Therefore, there are not many gaps in the tradition to retain the history."




- a. The sun is losing 5 million tons per second. At this rate, several billion years ago, the sun's gravity would have been much stronger, pulling the Earth into it.
- b. The earth's spin is slowing down about 1/1000 of a second per day. Because of this fact we have a "leap second" where a second is added to the clock every 10 months. Billions of years ago, the earth would have been spinning so fact that life on earth would have been impossible.
- c. The distance to the moon is increasing with each revolution. Since the moon obviously used to be closer to the earth.

- 5. The tower of Babel incident probably took place during the days of Pelag when the earth was divided (see Gen. 10.29). The languages, nationalities and possibly the races were created at the tower of Babel. Over the next first decades people migrated to all parts of the world before the earth was "divided." (Order video tope #6 for more information on this.)

- 6. If Peter 2: 8: "One day with the Lord is as a thousand jact billion! years, and a thousand year so one day." Bishop Usher calculated the creation to be 4004 B.C. (Our calendar is off by about four years since Christ was born eround 4 B.C.) Could it be that God is working on a 7000 year calendar for the each and that the 7th day (1000 years) is what is referred to in Rev. 20:2-7 and basis 11:6-16; 65:17-254 I wouldn't be dayserted about it, but it would be smart to be ready for I Thess. 4:16-18! (See also: Matt. 24:137-38); Luta 17: 26-27; Hab. 11:7; I Peter 3:20, II Peter 2:5].
- Methoselet's name apparently means "when he dies it shall come." Could it be that God told Enoch to name him that? The flood started when Methoselet died. Enoch did not know when his son would die.
   Maybe Enoch stayed so done to the Lord that God just took him to heaven without dying? See Gen. 5:21-24.)
- 8. Adam knew Methuselah for 243 years.
- 9. Shem knew Abraham, Issac and Jacob.

- 12. Noah had 6 living ancestors that could have known Adare personally.



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


The Book of Genesis, 231

"...there is a gradual decrease in the age of man. A sharp drop occurs between Shem and Arpachshad, between the first and second generation, during which time **the Flood** occurred. What probably caused the sudden decrease was the Flood. This was part of God's divine judgment on humanity."




"A second sharp drop occurs between Eber and Peleg, which are the fourth and fifth generations. It was between the fourth and fifth generation that the Tower of Babel event occurred. Therefore, with these two divine judgments, a sharp drop in the longevity of man occurs. If the canopy theory is correct, that might account for it. However, even without the canopy theory, divine judgment will easily account for this decrease, because it is following the divine judgments that the sharp drops occurred."
