<b>Weak External Evidence (Not Cited by Church Fathers Until 3<sup>rd</sup> Century)</b>	<b>Alternative reasons; Jude</b>
<b>Linguistic Differences Btw. 1 &amp; 2 Peter</b>	<b>Used a Secretary for 1 Peter (5:12)</b>
<b>Different Ideas Btw. 1 &amp; 2 Peter</b>	<b>Different Purposes Btw. 1 &amp; 2 Peter</b>
<b>Lived After Paul (2 Pet 3:15-16)</b>	<b>“All” Means “Known” Pauline Documents</b>
<b>Passing of the fathers (2 Pet 3:4)</b>	<b>Fathers = patriarchs (Rom 9:5)</b>

# Date (A.D. 64)

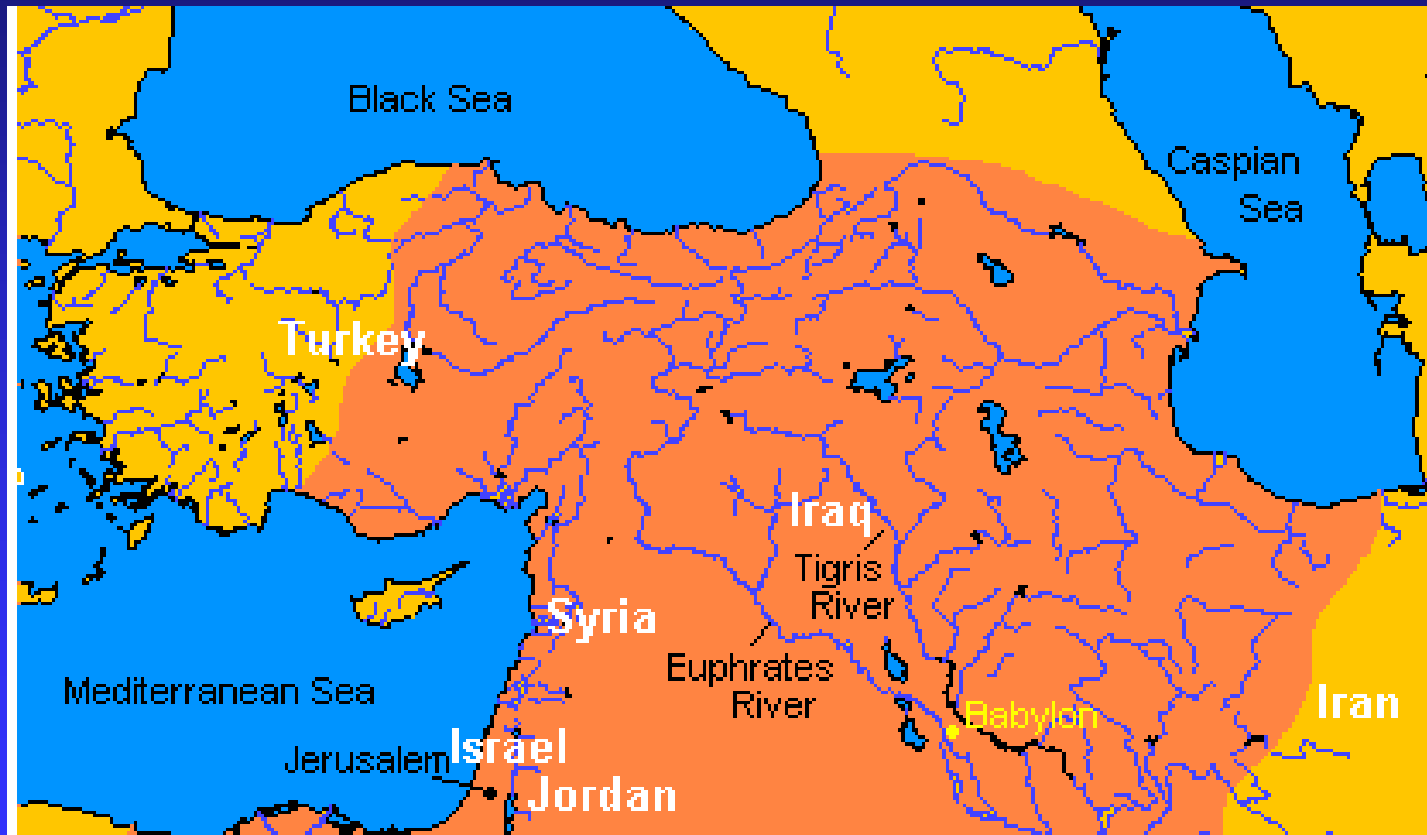
## ■ After

- ◆ A.D. 70 (destruction of Jerusalem)
- ◆ A.D. 68 (Paul's death)
- ◆ A.D. 67 (Peter's martyrdom)
- ◆ A.D. 64 (Neronian persecution)

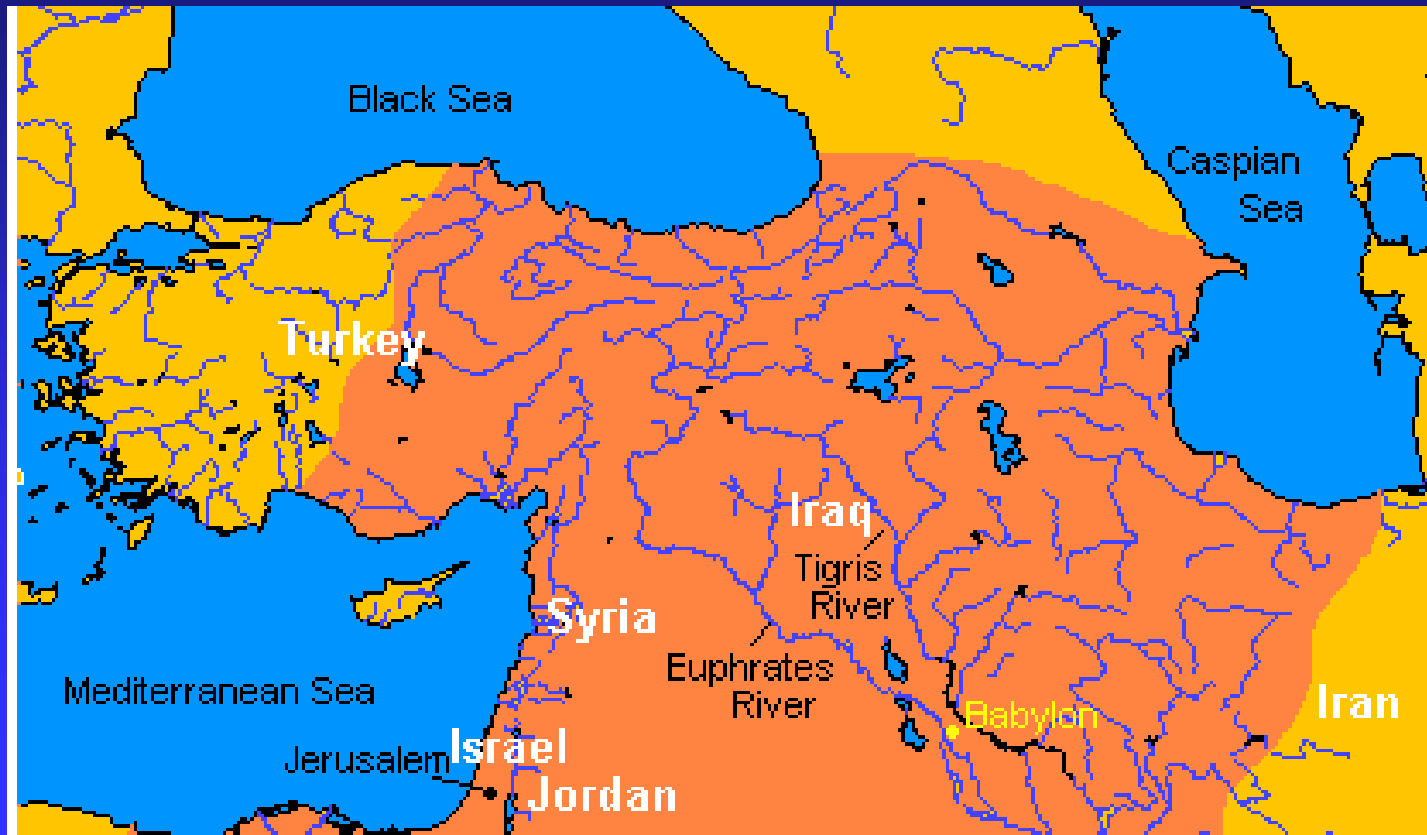

To build up his readers in the faith so that they will be insulated from the coming false teachers

Persecution	False teaching
Suffering	Error
Hope	Knowledge
Encourage	Expose
Comfort	Caution
Holiness	Maturity
Pain with a purpose	Poison in the pew
Christ exemplified suffering	Christ's return

Protection from the negative influence of the coming false teaches is accomplished through exhortation toward maturity and exposing the characteristics and doctrines of these coming false teachers



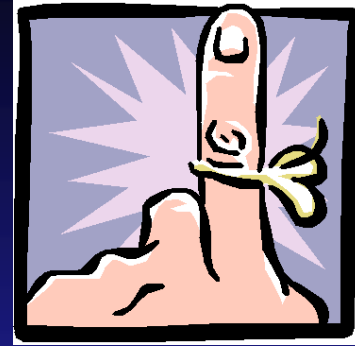
# Unique Characteristics

- Peter's last will and testament (2 Pet 1:14-15)
- Similarities with Jude
- Remembrance





# Remembrance



- Has forgotten that he has been cleansed (1:9)
- I will always remind you of these things (1:12)
- It is right to refresh your memory (1:13)
- You will always be able to remember these things (1:15)
- I have written both of them as reminders (3:1)
- Do not forget (3:8)
- Bear in mind (3:15)

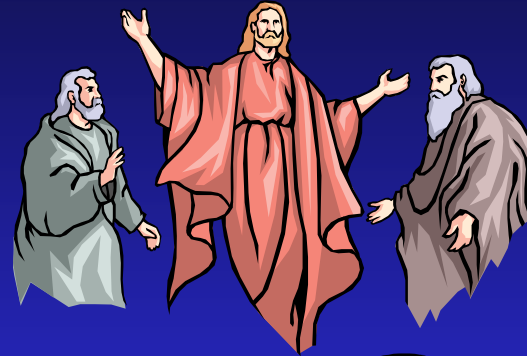

- Superior to Gnostics' Esoteric Knowledge
- Eyewitness to Christ's Transfiguration



# INSPIRATION OF SCRIPTURE

V. 20-21

- **Men Wrote as they were inspired by Holy Spirit**  
*“phero” = to carry*  
*Acts 27:15,17*
  
- **Opposite of Knowledge of False Teachers**
  - ◆ *Which is their own imagination*
  - ◆ *Jer. 23:16*



# AUTHORITY OF SCRIPTURE

- More sure than eyewitness testimony

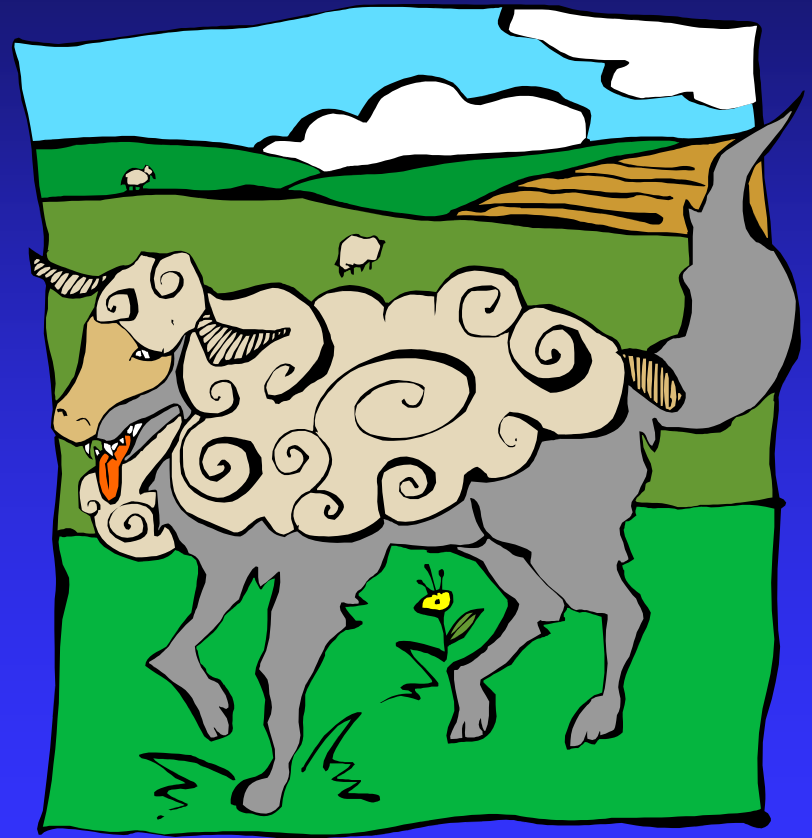

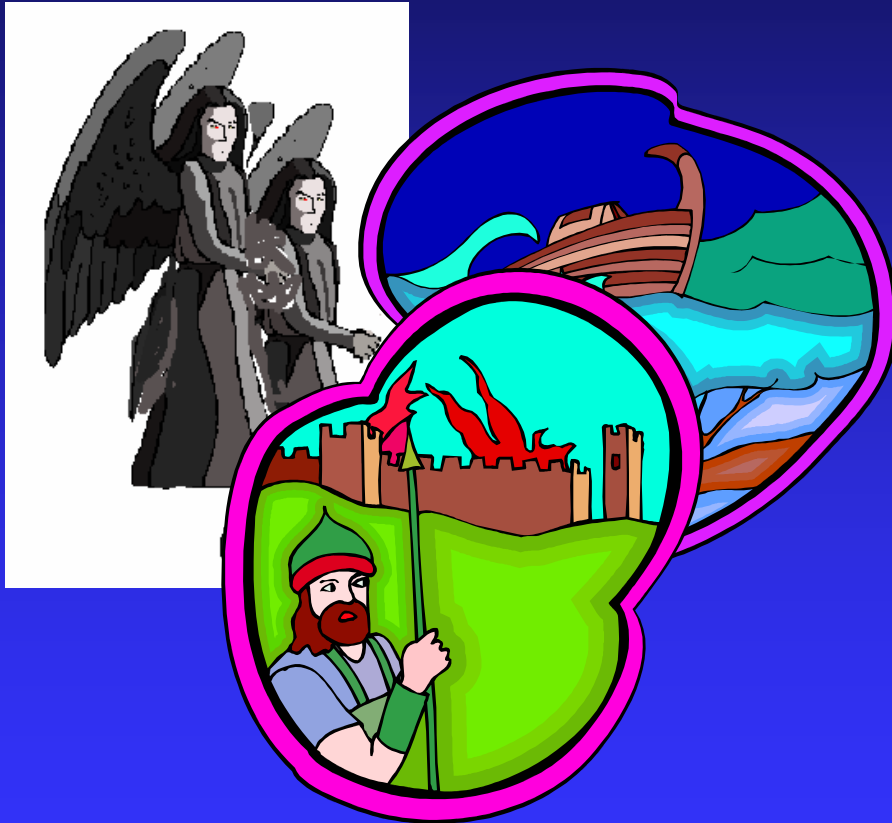

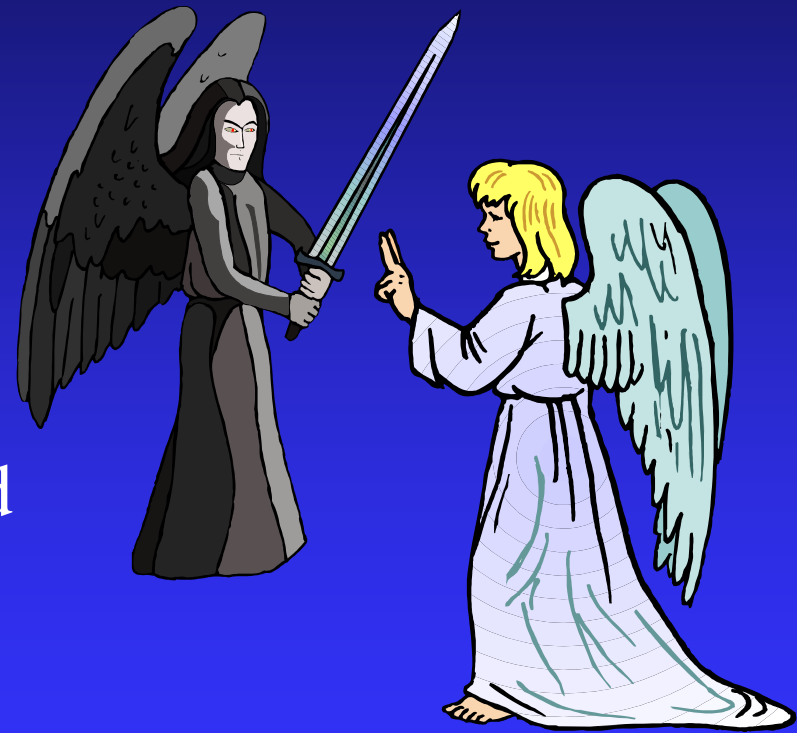

- Daring and Self-willed

- Shameless pleasure seekers
- Eyes full of adultery
- Entice unstable souls
- Greedy

■ Offer Nothing that is Permanently Satisfying

◆ Spring w/o water

◆ Mist

# REGRESSION

OF FALSE TEACHERS V. 20-22

- Return (20)
- Accountability to God is Greater (21)
- Two illustrations (22)

# Believer or Unbeliever?

## ■ Believer

- Purchased (1)
- Knowledge of Christ (20)
- Believers can sin (1:8-10)
- Examples of Lot and Balaam (7-8, 15-16)

## ■ Unbeliever

- Dogs/pigs (22)
- Overcome (20)
- Other unbelievers (4-6)
- Last state worse than the first (20)
- Darkness reserved (17)



# Peter's Second Purpose Statement (3:1-2)

- Back to the basics
- True source of knowledge
- Inspiration of both the prophets and apostles

# DOCTRINE OF FALSE TEACHERS v.3-4

- Deny 2<sup>nd</sup> coming

- ◆ Scoffing

- ◆ Future tense



# MOTIVE OF FALSE TEACHERS

V.3-4

- Deny 2<sup>nd</sup> coming
  - ◆ Lust & denial of judgment
  - ◆ Uniformitarianism / naturalism

V.5-10



Arguments from:

- Scripture
- God's character
- Divine promise

- Creation

- Flood

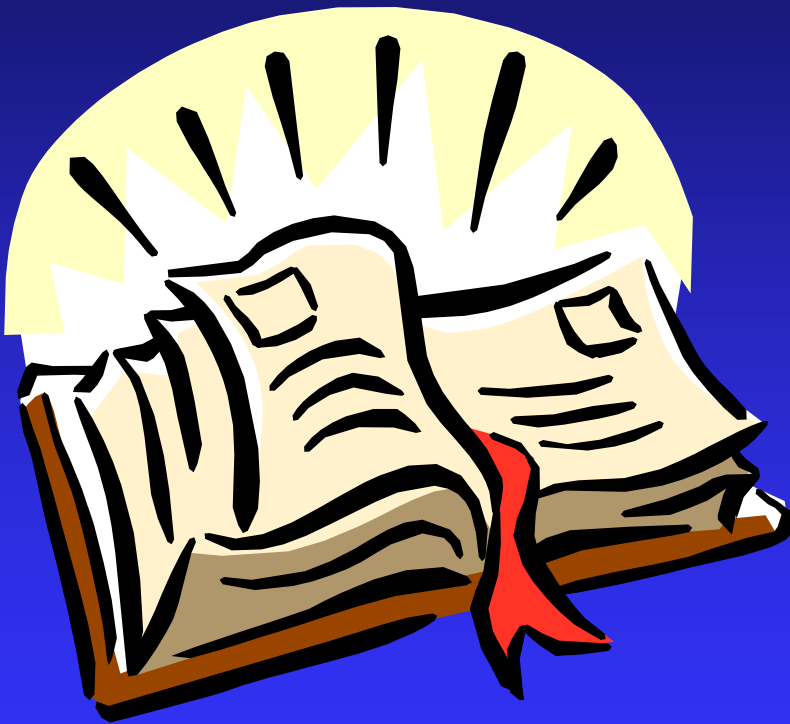
- ◆ God will judge again via fire





# SCRIPTURE

V. 8



- God's timing is not the same as ours

# GOD'S CHARACTER

v. 9

- Delay  $\neq$  no 2<sup>nd</sup> coming
- Delay = patience



# GOD'S PROMISE

V. 10



- Despite delay,  
the day will come:
- Like a thief
- According to God's  
promise

# Overview 2 Peter 3:15-18



- Regard the grace of God (v15)
- Beware of false teachers (v16-17)
- Grow in Christ (v18)

# Regard the Grace of God (3:15)

- 2 Pet 3:9
- Paul as an example of God's grace
- God even used Paul to author Scripture

## Beware of False Teachers (3:16-17)

- Paul's writings have given false teachers an opportunity
- Rev 22:18-19
- “Fall from your own steadfastness”?



# Grow in Christ (3:18)

- Maturity inoculates the believer against false teaching (Eph 4:11-16)
- God's glory is the ultimate motivation for maturity
