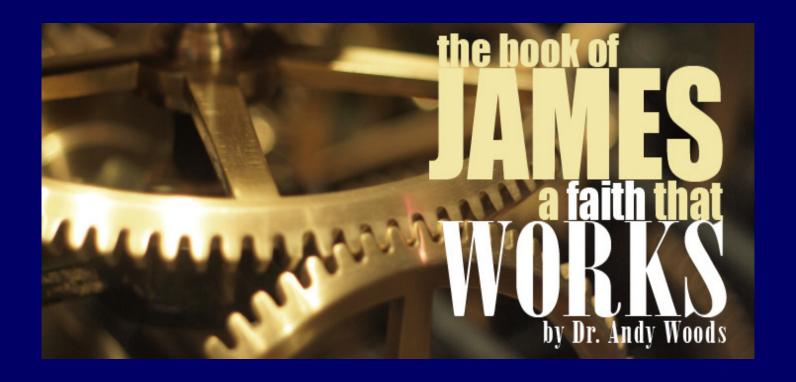





- III. Need for True Religion (1:26-27)



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


# Favoritism (2:1-13)

II. Situation: favoritism in the assembly (2:2-3)

III. Reasoning: favoritism is contrary to God's character & purposes (2:4-13)

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


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


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
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### **Ecclesiastes 1:9**

"That which has been is that which will be, And that which has been done is that which will be done. So there is nothing new under the sun."



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
