2. When Did the Church Begin?



- a. Christ referred to the Church in the future tense (Matt. 16:18)
- b. Paul referred to the Church as a "mystery" (Eph. 3:4-5, 9)
- c. The Church did not exist prior to Acts 1 since 5:23) after His Ascension (Eph. 1:20-22) Christ became the head of the Church (Eph.
- d. The Church did not exist prior to Acts 1 since into existence after His Ascension (Eph. 4:7-11) spiritual gifts (1 Cor. 12:7; 14:26) only came

- e. The Church existed before Paul's conversion in Acts 9 (Acts 5:11; 8:1,3; Rom. 16:7)
- The Baptizing *(joining, uniting, identifying)* ministry of the Holy Spirit began in Acts 2

Church ≠ Kingdom

- 1. Jesus Christ is never called the King of the Church
- 2. Jesus Christ's relationship to His Church is never depicted through the King-Kingdom metaphor
- 3. Prolonged Church Age carnality
- 4. Church Age Gospel = believe (Acts 16:30-31)
- 5. Kingdom's arrival is instantaneous (Dan. 2:44) 2:22) while the Church's construction is gradual (Eph.
- 6. Church = heir of the Kingdom (James 2:5)

4. Church ≠ Kingdom

- 7. Church suffers today (John 16:33)
- 8. Satanic influence on the Church (Ephes. 4:26-27)
- 9. The Times of the Gentiles continue
- 10. NT kingdom references predominantly future
- 11. Jesus Christ is never said to be ruling from David's Throne now
- 12. Kingdom miracles (Isa. 35:5-6) are absent today (2 Tim. 4:20)
- 13. Kingdom prosperity (Amos 9:11-15) is absent today (Acts 11:28)
