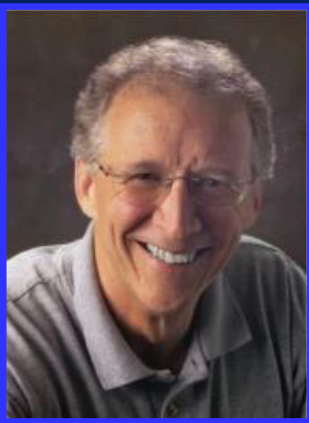


DTS Doctrinal Statement

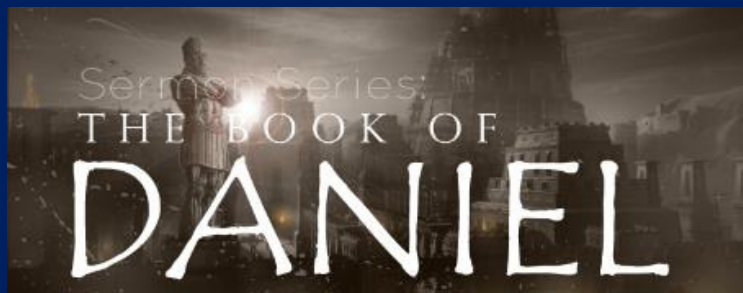
Message
