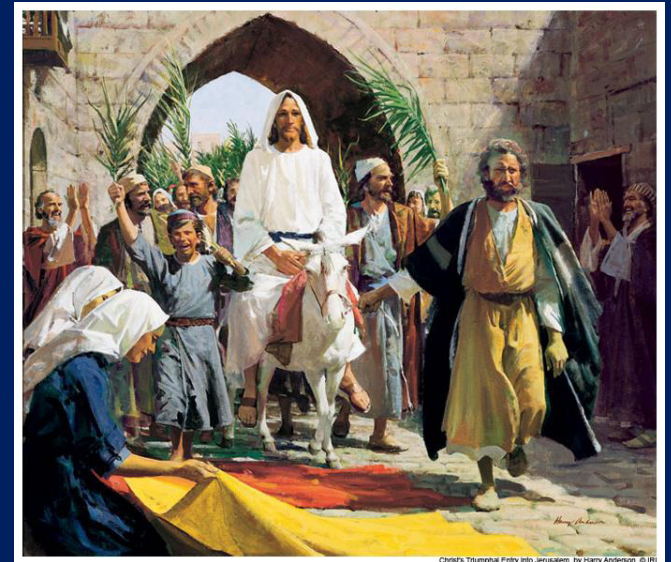

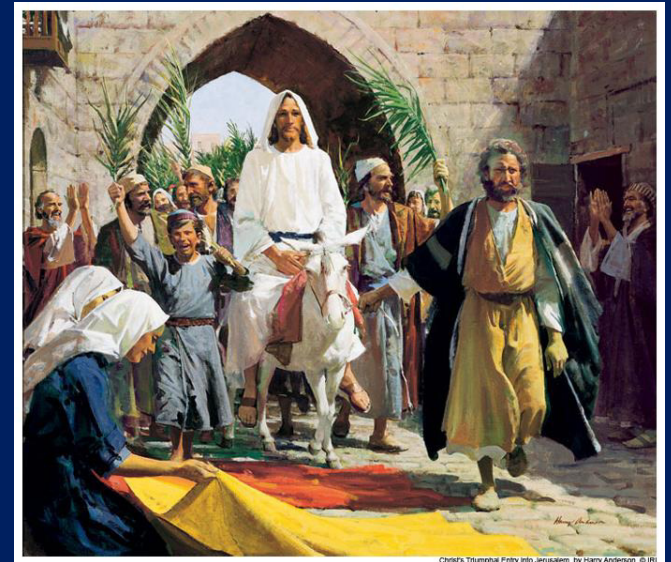

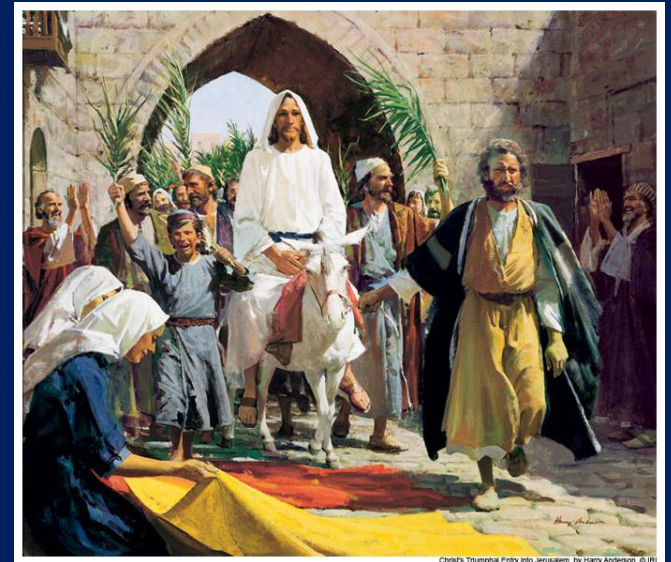

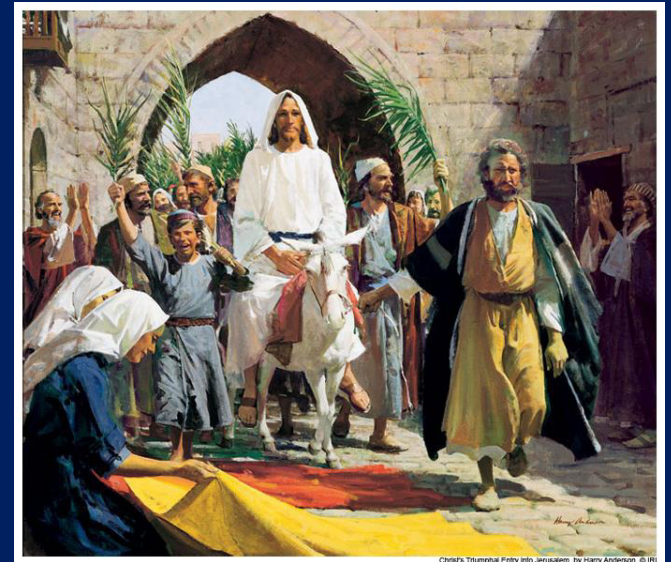

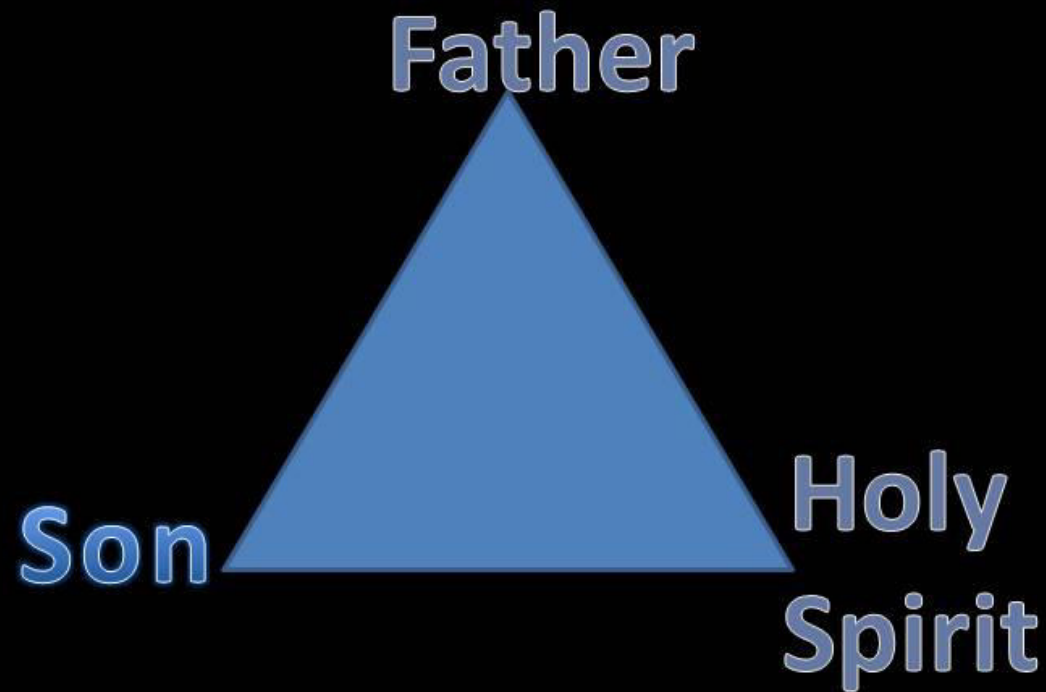

Order or *Tagma* (15:23)

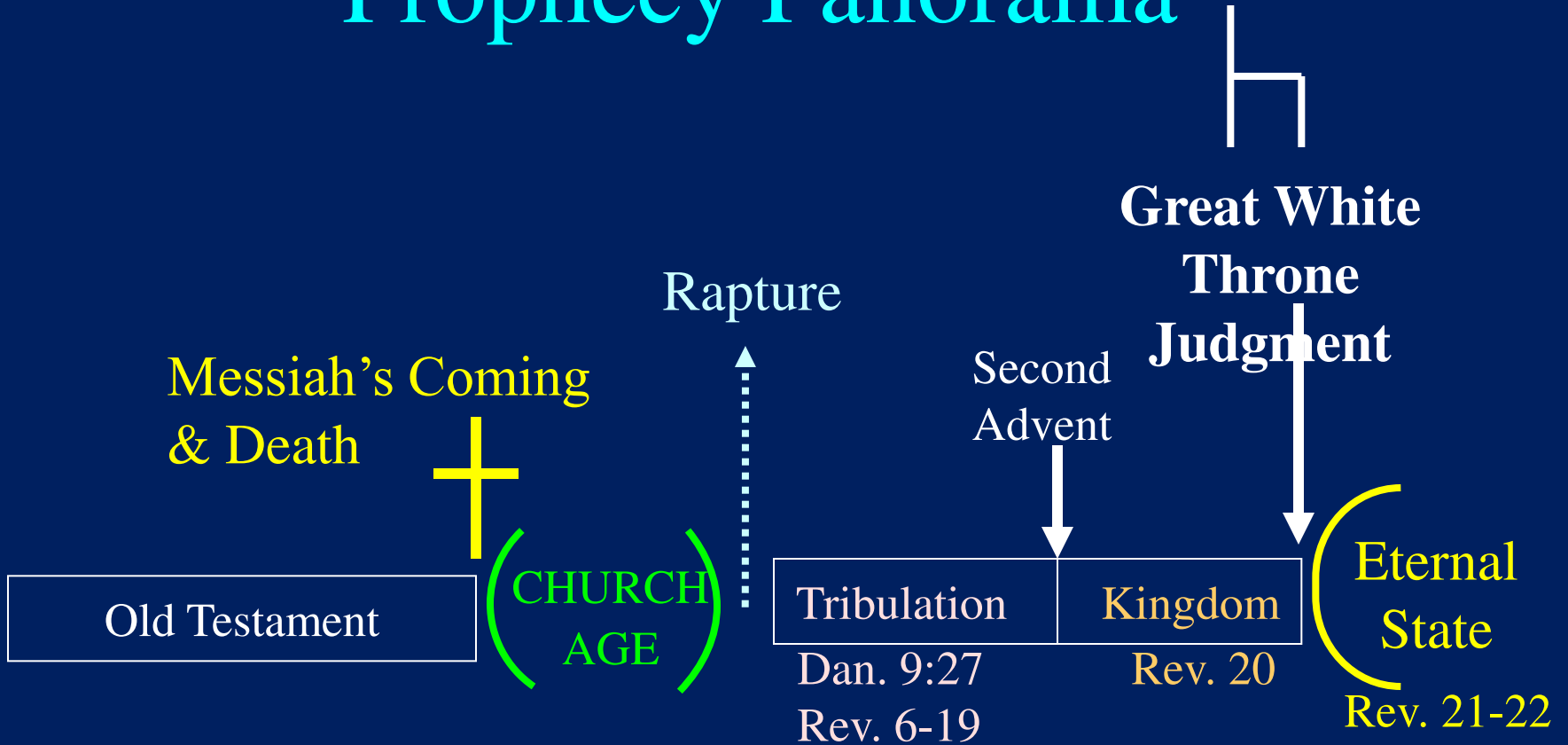
- General: Christ's resurrection (1 Cor 15:23)
