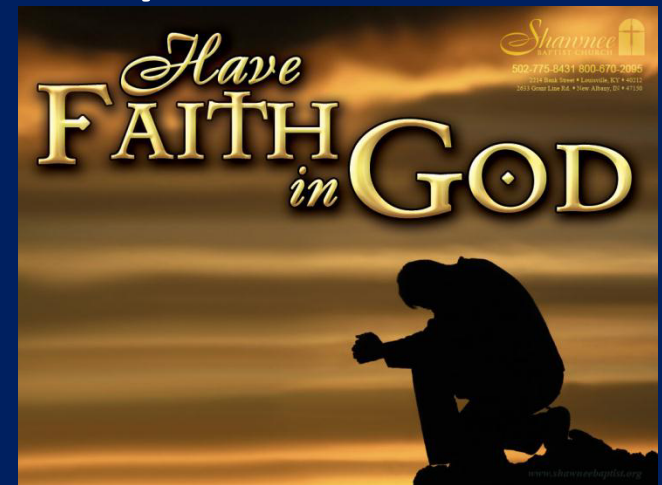
A. Positive: build (14:19)

Biblical Definitions of Sin

- Lawlessness (1 John 3:4)
- Unrighteousness (1 John 5:17)
- Something emanating not from faith (Rom 14:23)
- Haughty eyes, proud heart (Prov 21:4)
- Knows right yet refuses to do it (Jas 4:17)
- Self injury (Prov 8:36a)
