








Abrahamic Covenant


“The value of the minerals of the Dead Sea is estimated at five trillion dollars. This estimate appears to be optimistic but it is supported in part by the report of the Crown Agents of the British Colonies entitled ‘Production of Minerals From the Waters of the Dead Sea’ This official report estimates the minerals, except oil, in 1925 as follows: Magnesium Chloride, 22,000 tons, value 600 billion dollars; Potassium Chloride, 20,000 tons, value 75 billion dollars; other minerals valued at 1,200 billion dollars; or a total of about three trillion dollars, exclusive of oil.”







Various Christian traditions tell the story of Simon the Tanner, who lived in this house and hosted Peter the Apostle here. It was here that Peter raised Tabitha from the dead and saw his famous vision in which he was commanded to eat animals regarded as unclean in Jewish tradition. When he refused, he heard a voice saying: "What God has cleansed you must not call common" (Acts 10:15). Peter interpreted his vision as divine permission to forgo the Jewish commandments and to preach Christianity to Jews and pagans alike. This was a historic turning point, in which Christianity evolved from what was considered an esoteric sect of Judaism to a worldwide religion.

מסורות נוצריות שונות מספרות על שמעון הבורסקאי, שגר בבית זה, ואירח בו את פטרוס, שליחו של ישו. כאן ביצע פטרוס את נס החייאתה של טביטא, וחלם את חלומו המפורסם. בחלומו צוה פטרוס לאכול חיות טמאות וטהורות. כאשר סירב, שמע קול אומר: "לאשר טיהר אלוהים, אתה אל תקרא טמא". פטרוס פירש את החלום כהיתר אלהי לוותר על מצוות היהדות ולהפיץ את הנצרות בקרב היהודים ועובדי האלילים כאחד. זוהי נקודת מפנה היסטורית, ממנה צמחה הנצרות, שעד אז נחשבה לכת איזוטרית בתוך היהדות, והפכה לדת חובקת שלם.




