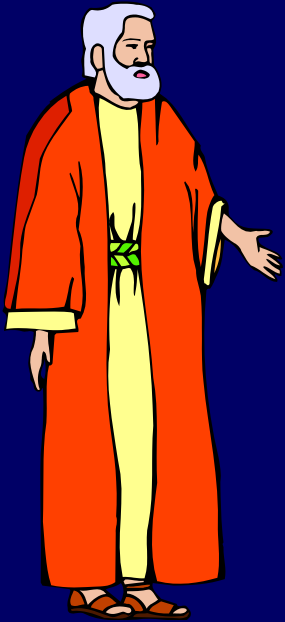

- Unique characteristics: Knowledge

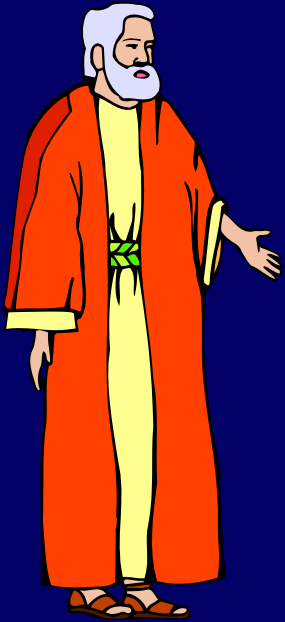
