Recognizing a False Gospel

False gospels place the spotlight on what man does rather than what Christ has done

False gospels emphasize a process rather than a person

False gospels deny the five solas

The Five Solas (Alone or By Itself)

- Solus Christus-Christ alone
- Sola Fide-faith alone
- Sola Gratia-grace alone
- The Five Solas

 Sola scriptura (Scripture Alone)

 Solus Christus (Christ Alone)

 Sola gratia (Grace Alone)

 Sola fide (Faith Alone)

 Soli Deo gloria (Glory to God Only)
- Sola Scriptura-Scripture alone
- Soli Deo Gloria-To the glory of God alone

Religion says...

Jesus Christ did 90%

You must do 10%

This is salvation by works.

God says...

Jesus Christ did 100%

This is salvation by God's grace.

- Soli Deo Gloria-To the glory of God alone


Three Tenses of Salvation

Scripture	Eph 2:8-9; Titus 3:5	Philip 2:12	Rom 5:10


Work of the Spirit in the OT vs. Today

	OT/Gospels	Today
Reception of all of the Spirit at the moment of salvation?	Subsequent to salvation (Exod 31:3)	At moment of salvation (Rom 8:9)
How long is the indwelling?	Temporary indwelling (1 Sam 16:14; Ps 51:11)	Permanent indwelling (John 14:16)
Who is indwelt?	Selective indwelling (Joel 2:28)	Universal indwelling (1 Cor 12:13)




Onesiphorus as a positive example of endurance (1:16-18)


- Refreshed Paul (1:16a)
