3	Daniel's 3 friends cast into the fiery furnace	19 or 20
4	Interpreting Nebuchadnezzar's 2nd dream (huge tree)	45-50
5	Interpreting handwriting of the wall at Belshazzar's feast	Early 80's
6	Delivered from the den of lions	c.83
7-8	Daniel's visions and dreams	Mid-60's
9	Daniel's seventy "sevens" prophecy	Early-80's
10-12	Final dreams and visions	Mid-80's

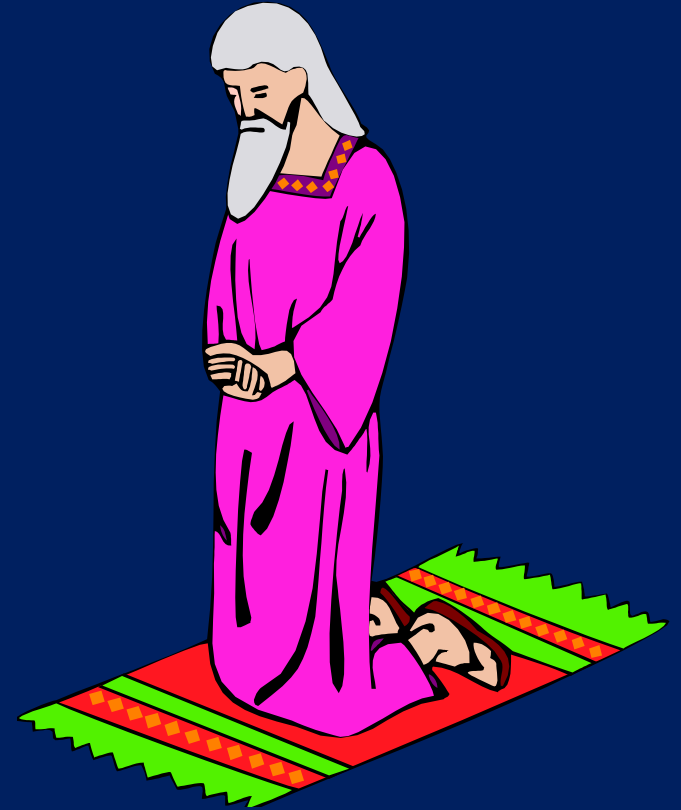

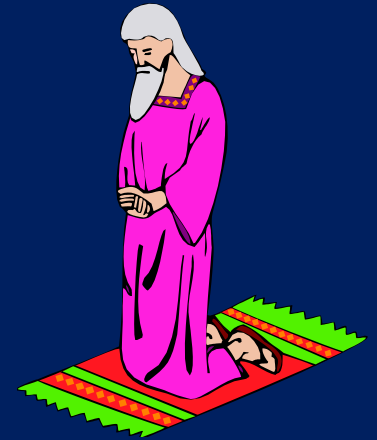

- ◆ Daniel was not too busy for these priorities

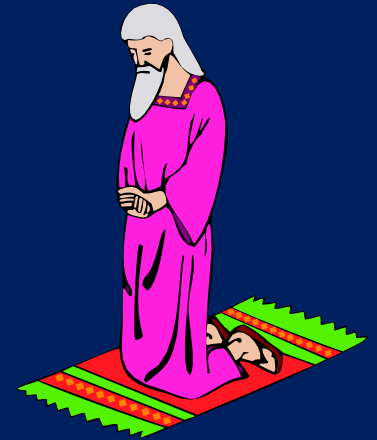


SETTING : PROPHETIC

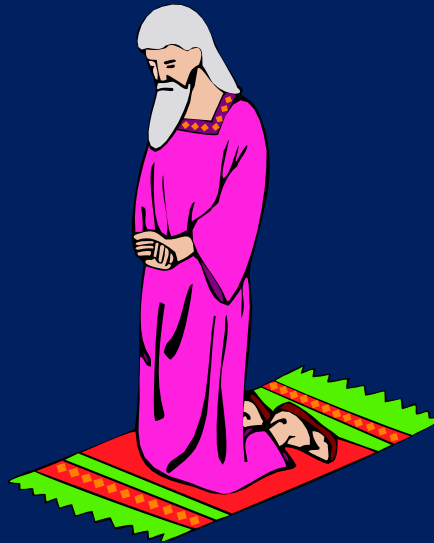
Abrahamic Covenant



Unconditional covenant with a conditional blessing (Deut. 28; Lev. 26)

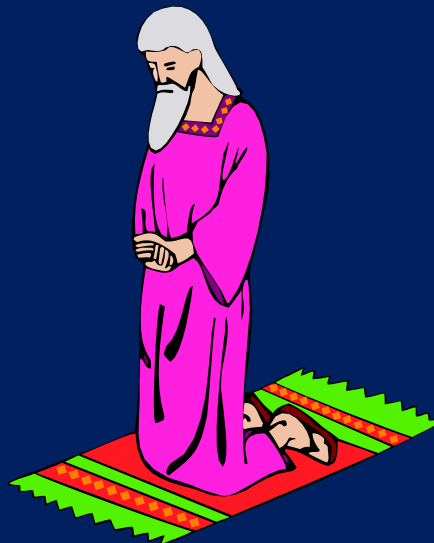

- ◆ Gabriel's previous involvement (8:16)

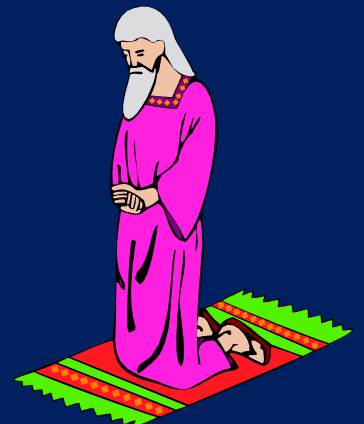

- ◆ Daniel's misconception of the kingdom's coming after 70 years

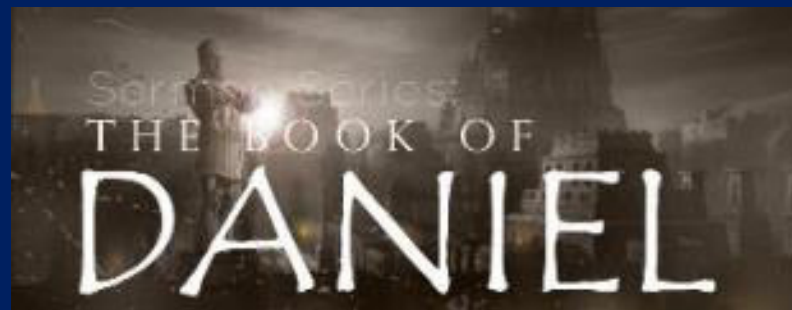
