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


Revelation 20:4-6

"⁴ Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life [*zaō*] and reigned with Christ for a thousand years....

Revelation 20:4-6

...⁵ The rest of the dead <u>did not come to life [zaō]</u> until the thousand years were completed. This is the <u>first resurrection [anastasis]</u>. ⁶ Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the <u>first resurrection</u> [anastasis]; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years."

⁶ For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.⁷ There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. Revelation 14:11


"And the smoke of their torment goes up forever (aion) and ever (aion); they have no rest day and night, those who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name."

Dominoes in a Row







1 Corinthians 15:20-23

God's Resurrection Program





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

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
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Purpose
