





Definition of Ecclesiology


- Ekklēsía (ἐκκλησία)



"The **Upper Room Discourse**, which the above passage is found, is the seed-plot of that form doctrine which is later developed in the Epistles. It is not strange, therefore, that the Apostle Paul takes up this great theme for further elucidation."



Seed Truths (John 13-17)

- 1. believers' oneness in Christ (John 17:20-23; Eph 2:11-22)
- 2. Spirit's permanent residence in the believer (John 14:16; Eph 4:30)
- 3. believer's union with Christ (John 14:20; Gal 2:20; Rom 6:1-14)
- 4. believer's opposition to the world (John 15:18-19; Jas 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17)
- 5. necessity of believer to stay in fellowship with Christ (John 13:10; 15:1-17; 1 John 1:5-7, 9)



Seed Truths (John 13–17)

- 6. abiding in Christ as a prerequisite for fruit bearing (John 15:1-7; Philip 4:13)
- 7. believer's election (John 15:16; Eph 1:4)
- 8. Christ as the ultimate model of sacrificial living and service (John 13:1-20; Philip 2:5-11)
- 9. necessity of divine discipline in the believer's life (John 15:2; Heb 12:5-11)
- 10.Satan as the god of this age (John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11; 2 Cor 4:4; Eph 2:2)





- 13.the Spirit as the illuminator of all Scripture (John 14:26; 16:13; 1 Cor 2:14; 1 John 2:20, 27)
- 14. Christ's provision of peace in the midst of adversity (John 14:27; Philip 4:7)
- 15.necessity of the Sprit's convicting ministry as a prerequisite for salvation (John 16:7-11; 1 Cor 2:14; 2 Cor 4:4)

- 16. normalcy of tribulations in the present age (John 16:33; Jas 1:2-4)
- 17. believer as the ultimate over comer (John 16:33; 1 John 4:4; 5:4-5)
