- "Against such things there is no Law"
- Point of the book
  - Sanctification not by the Law
  - Sanctification by the Spirit
  - Fruit of the Spirit

- 2: Do not make any idols
- 3: Do not misuse the name of God
- 4: Keep the Sabbath holy

#### MAN

- 5: Honour your father & mother
- 6: Do not murder
- 7: Do not commit adultery
- 8: Do not steal
- 9: Do not lie
- 10: Do not covet
