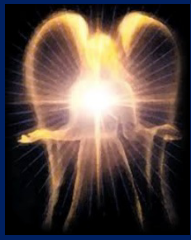


Old Satan Deluder Law: 1642 Massachusetts

Woman created from man's side...not his foot

- Helper and not slave (Gen 2:18)
- To complete what is lacking in man
- “Helper” (*ezer*) also used of God (Exod 18:4; Deut 33:7; 1 Sam 7:12)
- Same essence as Adam (2:24)
- Both sexes retain the image of God (Gen 1:27-28)
- Both sexes are co-rulers (Gen 1:26-28)
- Trinitarian analogy
- No feminism or chauvinism
