"The next thing he did was: And he took one of the stones of the place, and put it under his head, which has been misunderstood to mean that he used it as a pillow, but a stone would make a rather uncomfortable pillow. The Hebrew literally reads, 'at his head,' not 'under his head.' It means the stone was placed at his head, as was the case with Saul's spear in I Samuel 26:7, where the same terminology is used. 


The Book of Genesis, 438-39

"In verse 20b–21a, he focused on what God would do, beginning in verse 21b with God's provision for Jacob: *If God will be with me*, meaning if God's presence will be indeed with him. The word if can also mean 'since.' [Since] God will be with me, which is really more of a response of gratitude than a response of testing, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on."
