


ARGUMENTS FOR AND AGAINST PETRINE AUTHORSHIP

CRITICISM	ANSWER
Weak External Evidence (Not Cited by Church Fathers Until 3 rd Century	Alternative reasons; Jude
Linguistic Differences Btw. 1 & 2 Peter	Used a Secretary for 1 Peter (5:12)
Different Ideas Btw. 1 & 2 Peter	Different Purposes Btw. 1 & 2 Peter
Lived After Paul (2 Pet 3:15-16)	"All" Means "Known" Pauline Documents
Passing of the fathers (2 Pet 3:4)	Fathers = patriarchs (Rom 9:5)

Date (A.D. 64)

- After
 - ◆ 1 Peter (2 Pet 3:1)
 - ◆ Paul wrote some of his letters (2 Pet 3:15-16)
- Before
 - ◆ A.D. 70 (destruction of Jerusalem)
 - ◆ A.D. 68 (Paul's death)
 - ◆ A.D. 67 (Peter's martyrdom)
 - ◆ A.D. 64 (Neronian persecution)






Occasion for Writing

Purpose

To build up his readers in the faith so that they will be insulated from the coming false teachers

Protection from the negative influence of the coming false teaches is accomplished through exhortation toward maturity and exposing the characteristics and doctrines of these coming false teachers




Creation
