 - ◆ Accidental

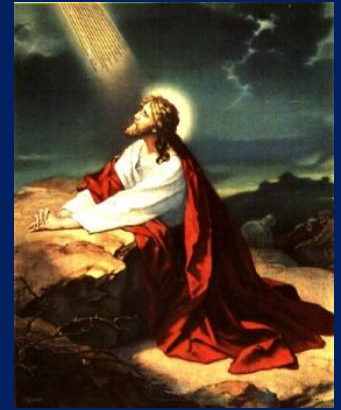

JERUSALEM AT THE TIME OF JESUS

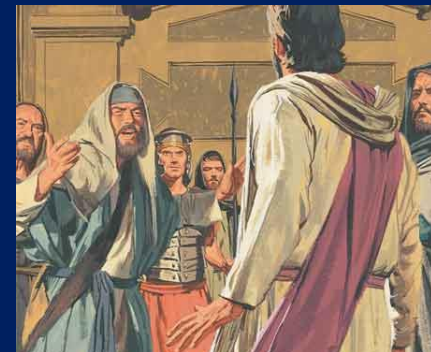

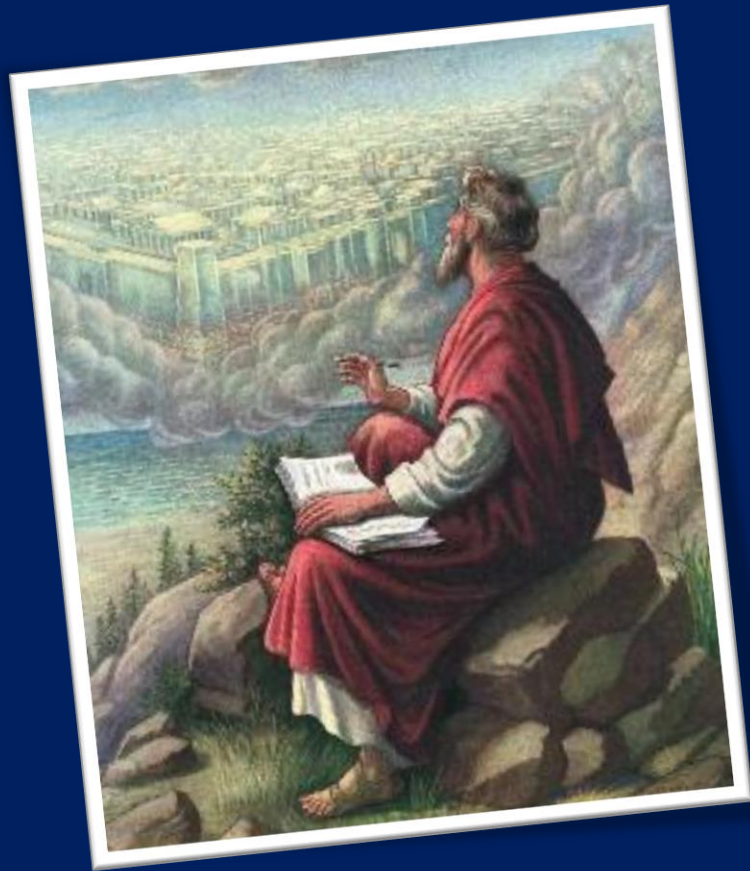
