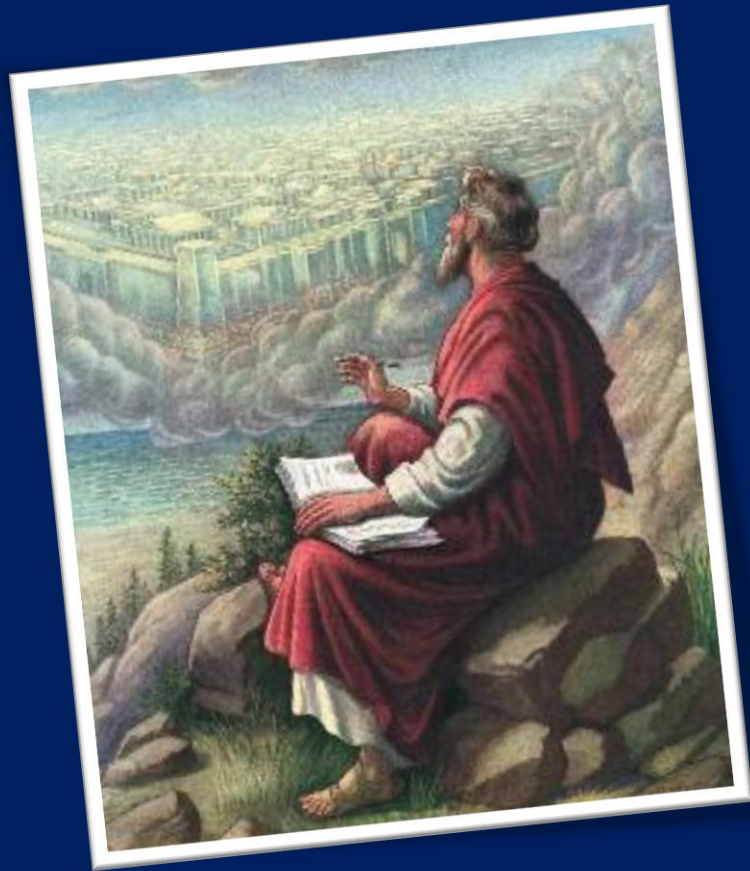

Romans 8:29–30

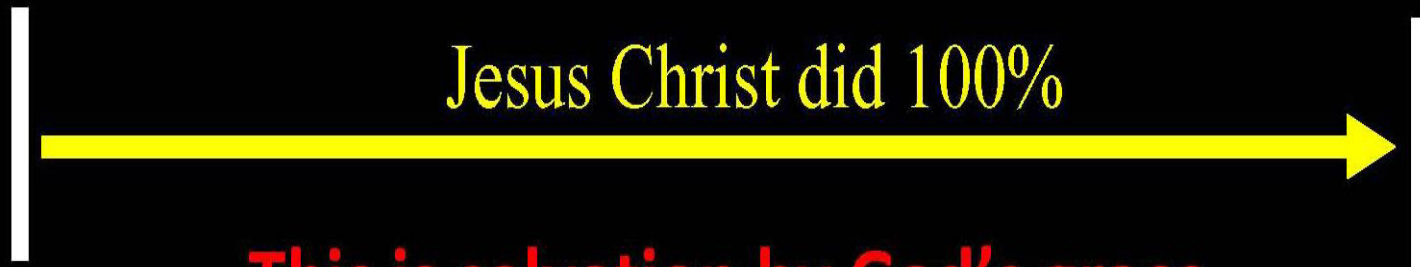
