You must do 10%


This is salvation by works.

False Invitations

- Ask Jesus into your heart
- Give your life to Jesus
- Make a commitment to Jesus
- Turn the controls of your life over to Jesus
- Believe and be baptize
- Believe and keep the 10 commandments
- Submit to Jesus' mastery
- Repent of your sins
- Confess your sins
- Come forward

- 1. Bad News #1: You are a sinner before a holy God. Romans 3:23
- 2. Bad News #2: The penalty for your sin is death. *Romans* 6:23
- 3. Good News #1: God in His infinite love provided Jesus Christ Who died for you and paid your sin penalty.

Romans 5:8

- 4. Good News #2: You can be saved from hell by depending upon Jesus Christ alone to save you. *Ephesians 2:8-9*
- 5. Good News #3: God wants you to know FOR SURE that you are saved and have eternal life. 1 John 5:13
