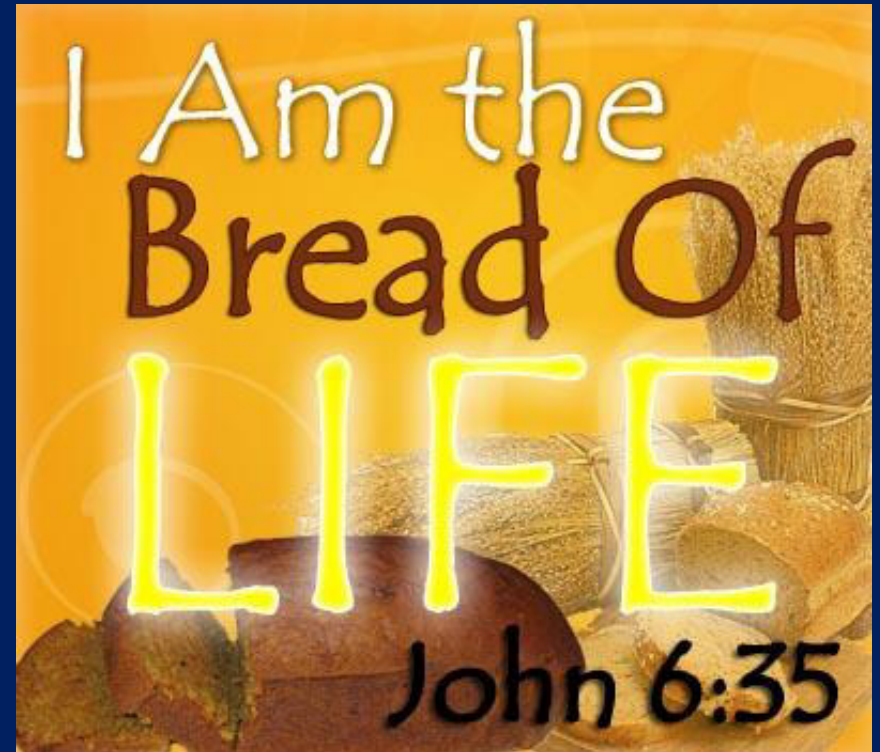
SEA OF GALILEE

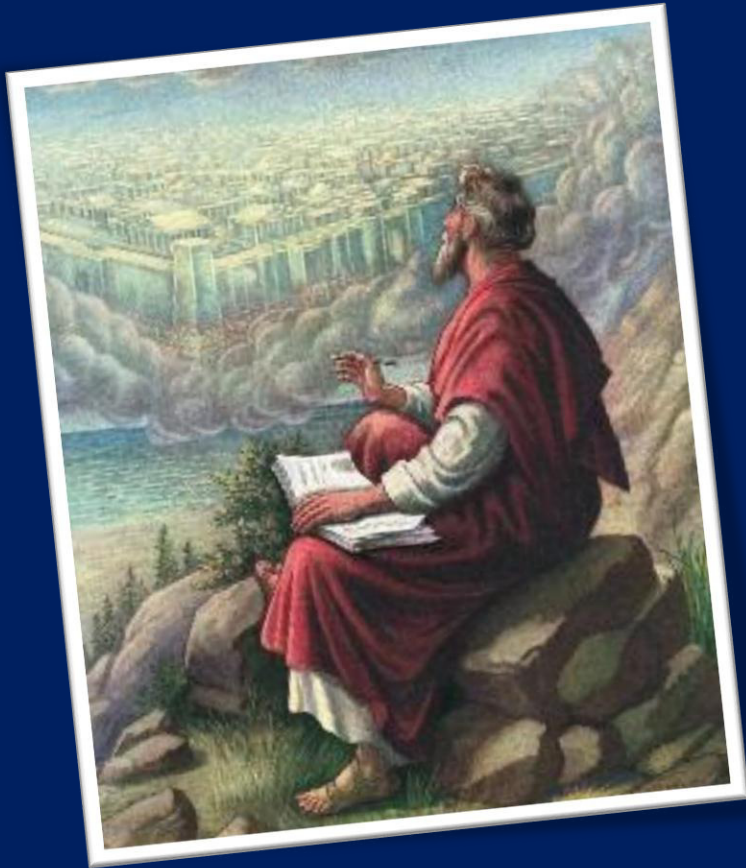
SLBC Statement of Faith



Article 3.6-God has provided the remedy for our disobedience by sending His Son, Jesus Christ, to be the sacrifice for our sins. 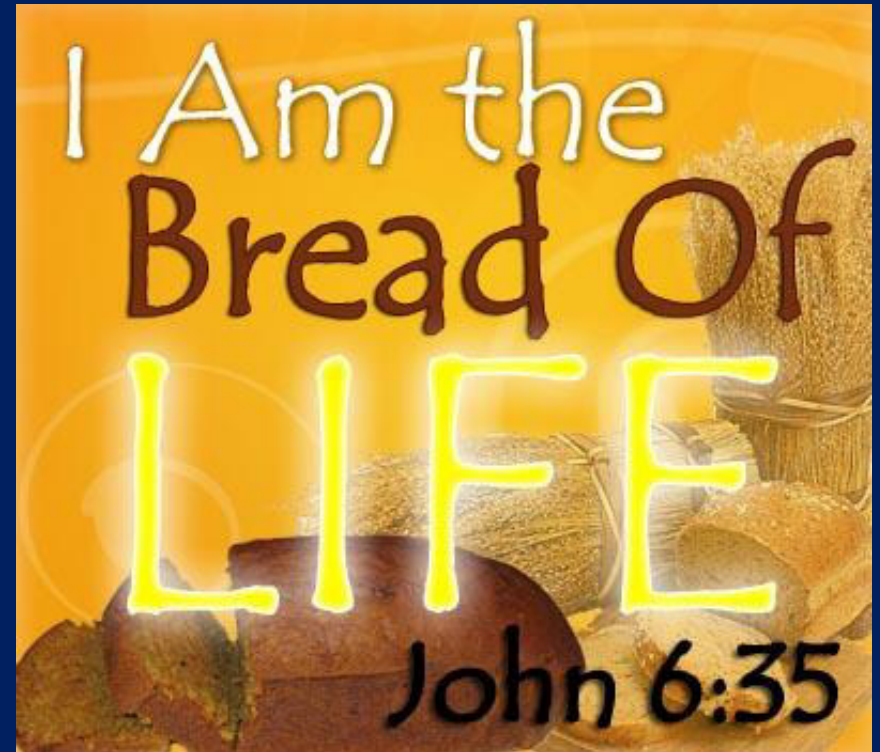
