



- 6) Why was it written? Evangelism
- 7) What is it about? Jesus gives life to believers
- 8) How does the writer accomplish his goal? <u>Selective</u> <u>history</u>
- 9) What is inside (outline)? <u>5 part outline</u>
- 10) What makes the book different? Emphasis on believe


