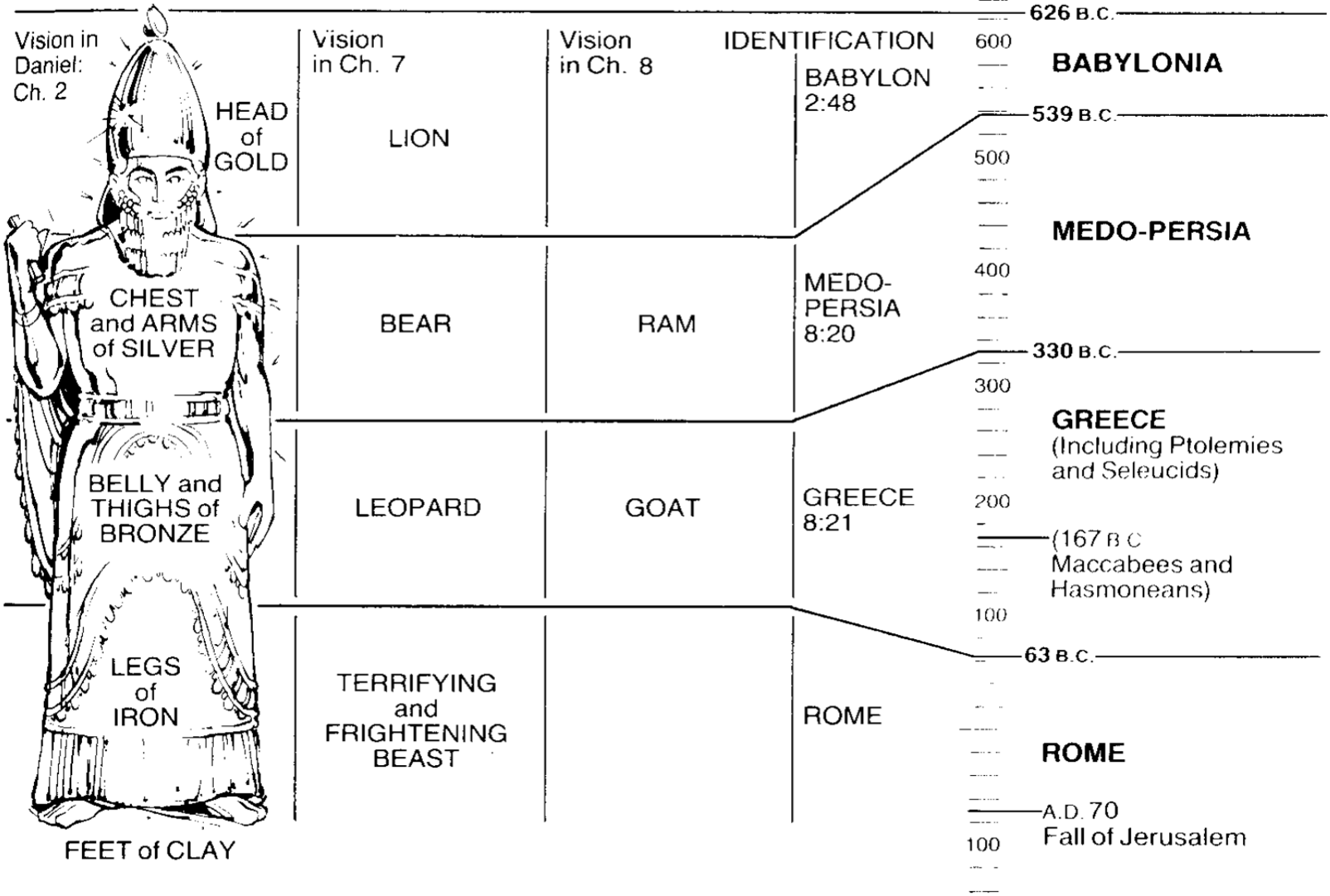

Chronology of Major Empires in Daniel

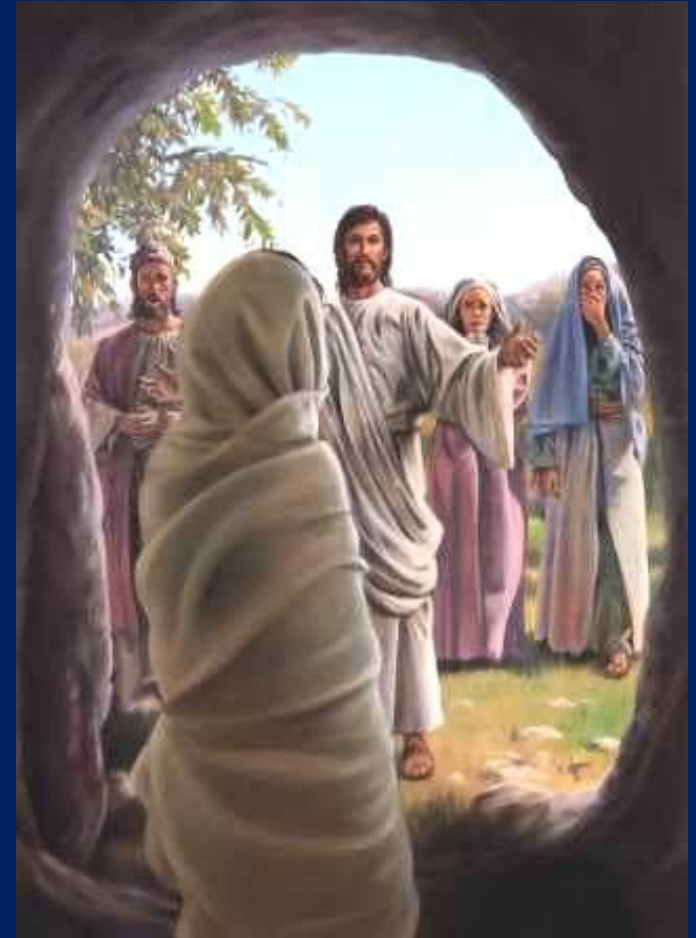
