Tribulation = divine wrath (Rev 6:16-17; 11:18; 15:1, 7; 16:19)














# **The Millennium Temple**

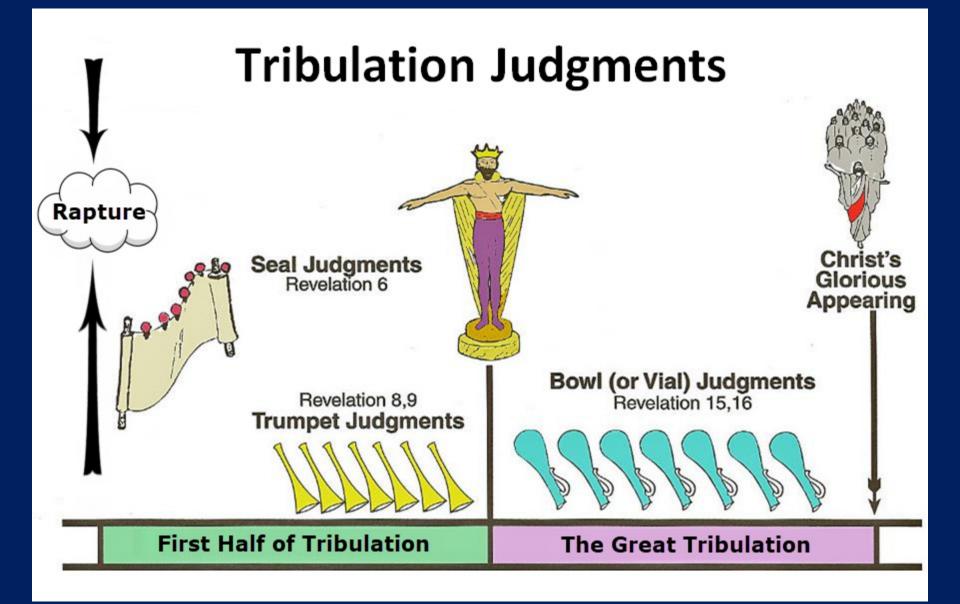
