- a. Circumcision came later (9-10)
- b. Circumcision is a sign (11a)
- c. Abraham is the father of all believing (11b-12)



- 3. Not by the Law (13-16)
 - a. Inheritance by faith and not Law (13)
 - b. Law nullifies faith (14)
 - c. Law cannot save (15)
 - d. Abraham the father of all believers (16)

b. How Abraham Was Justified (4:17-22)

- 1. God as the object of faith (17)
- 2. Obstacles to Abraham's faith overcome (18-22)
 - a. Abraham believed despite impossibilities (18-19)

 - a. Father raised Christ (24b)
 - b. Christ died for our sins (25a)
