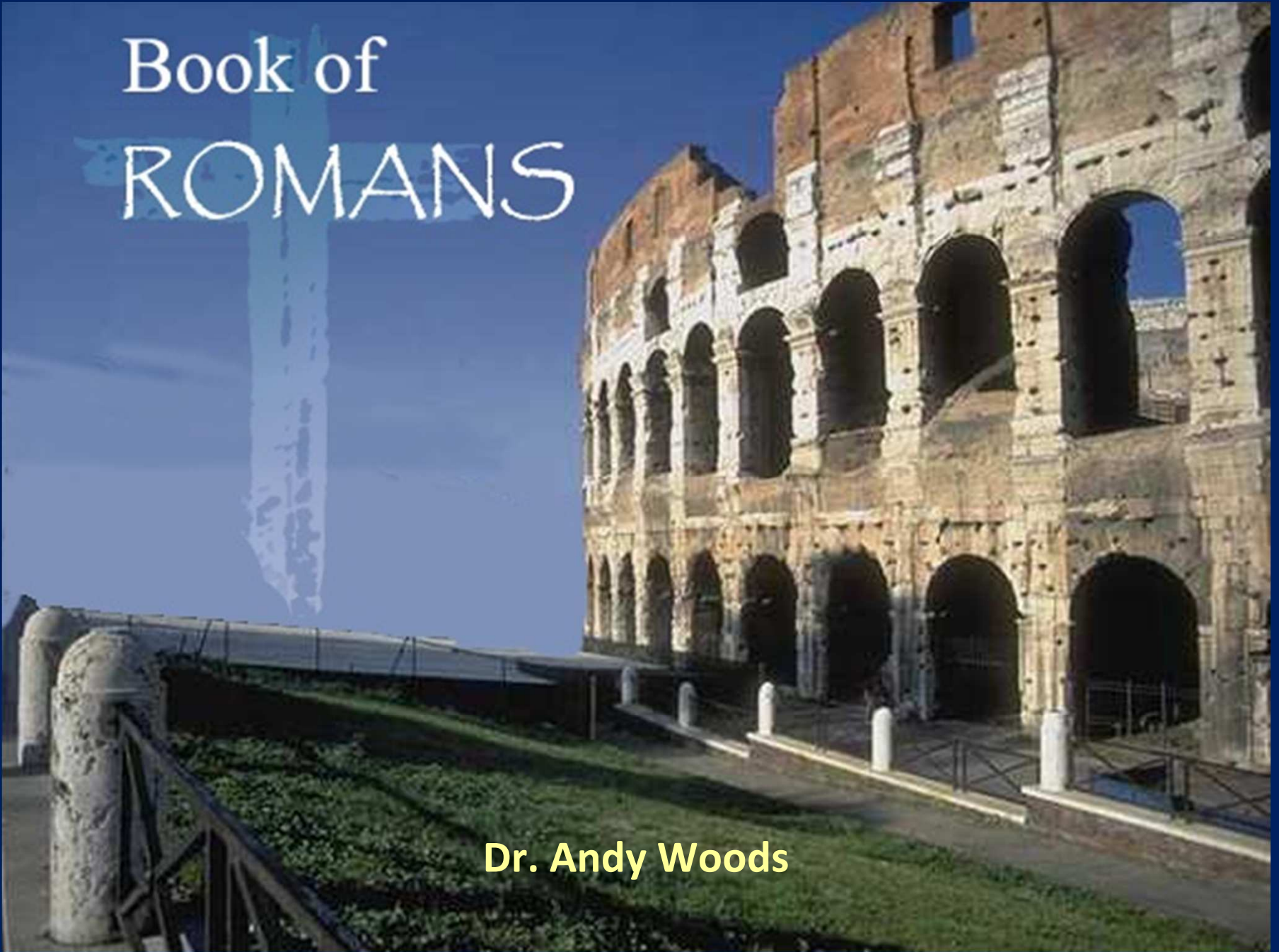
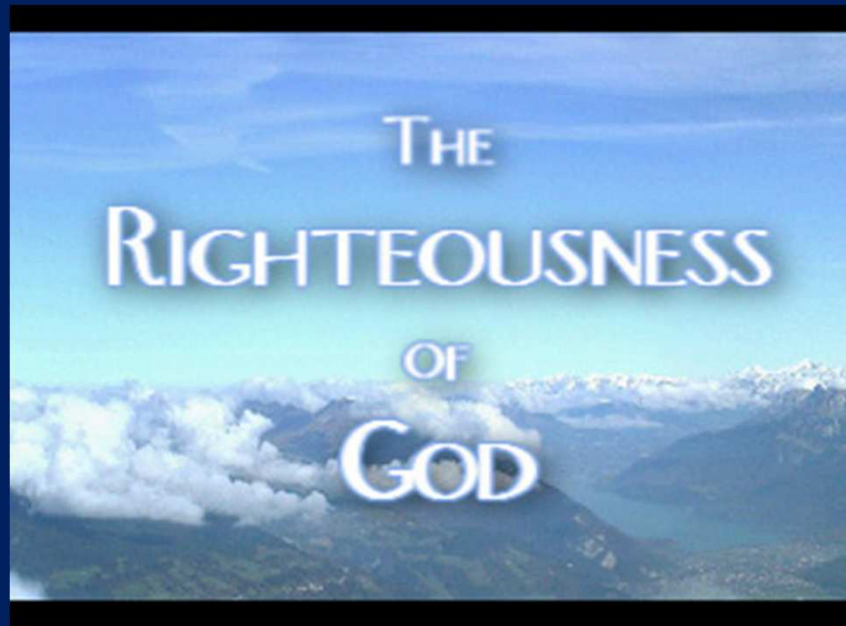

# Three Tenses of Salvation

<b>Phase</b>	<b>Justification</b>	<b><u>Sanctification</u></b>	<b>Glorification</b>
<b>Tense</b>	<b>Past</b>	<b><u>Present</u></b>	<b>Future</b>
<b>Saved from sin's:</b>	<b>Penalty</b>	<b><u>Power</u></b>	<b>Presence</b>
<b>Scripture</b>	<b>Eph 2:8-9; Titus 3:5</b>	<b><u>Philip 2:12</u></b>	<b>Rom 5:10</b>

# Sanctification (6–8)

- Believer's relationship to sin-6
- Believer's relationship to the Law-7
- Believer's relationship to the Spirit-8





# Believer's Relationship to the Spirit (8:1-39)

- 1) Spirit transferred us from death to life (8:1-11)
- 2) We are not obligated to the flesh but to the Spirit (8:12-17)
- 3) We endure suffering now in the hope of future glory (8:18-30)
- 4) We are secure in Christ (8:31-39)





## Life in the Spirit Described (8:14-17)

1) We are now led by the Spirit (14a)

2) Consequences (14b-17)

a. Leading indicates sonship (14b)

b. Sonship indicates childship (15-16)

c. Childship indicates heirship (17)

# Because Future Glory Exceeds Present Suffering (8:18-25)

- 1) Proposition stated (8:18)
- 2) Proposition proved (8:19-25)
  - a) Proof #1-From nature (8:19-22)
  - b) Proof #2-From awaiting a new body (8:23-25)



# Proof # 1 - From Nature (8:19-22)

- 1) Creation's expectation (8:19)
- 2) Creation's subjugation (8:20)
- 3) Creation's liberation (8:21)
- 4) Creation's groaning (8:22)



## Proof # 2 - From Awaiting New Body (8:23-25)

- 1) Redemption of our bodies (8:23)
- 2) Hope defined (8:24)
- 3) Hope requires perseverance (8:25)



# Because of Assistance of the Spirit (8:26-27)

- 1) General help (8:26a)
- 2) Specific help (8:26b-27)



# Because All Things Work Together for Good (8:28-30)

- 1) Proposition stated (8:28)
- 2) Proposition explained (8:29)
- 3) Salvation enumerated (8:30)

## Romans 8:29-30

For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to become* conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren; and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.
