- Book of the covenant
- All areas of life
- Longer

- Casuistic



Book of the Covenant Applies to All Areas of Life (Exod 20:22–23:33)

- idolatry (20:22-26)
- slavery (21:1-11)
- bodily injuries (21:12-36)
- property rights (22:1-17)
- moral and civil obligations (22:18–23:9)
- Sabbath and feasts (23:10–19)
- impending conquest (23:20-33)

Three Tenses of Salvation

Phase	Justification	<u>Sanctification</u>	Glorification
Tense	Past	<u>Present</u>	Future
Saved from sin's:	Penalty	<u>Power</u>	Presence
Scripture	Eph 2:8-9; Titus 3:5	<u>Philip 2:12</u>	Rom 5:10

Romans 8:29–30

29 For those whom He **foreknew**, He also **predestined** *to become* conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren; ³⁰ and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He **called**, He also justified; and these whom He **justified**, He also **glorified**.

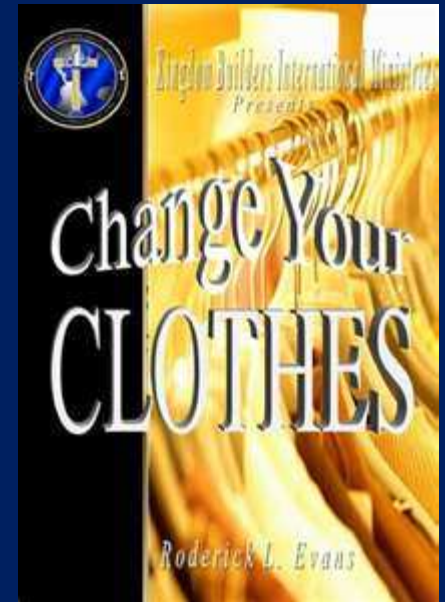
