  - a. Liberal attacks on God's word
  - b. Evangelical waning confidence in God's word

  - a. Scripture is written by men and yet inspired by God (Matt 22:43; John 10:34-45; 16:12-13)
  - b. All Scripture is God's word (Matt 23:35; 4:4; 5:18)
  - c. Scripture is without error (John 17:17)
  - d. Scripture is historically accurate (Matt 19:3-6; 12:40; Luke 17:26-30)
  - e. Scripture would never fail (Luke 16:17; John 10:35)
  - f. Scripture is the highest authority (Matt 4:1-11; Luke 4:1-13)
  - g. Scripture is capable of sustaining a person during his darkest hour (Luke 23:46; Ps 119:105; Job 23:12)
