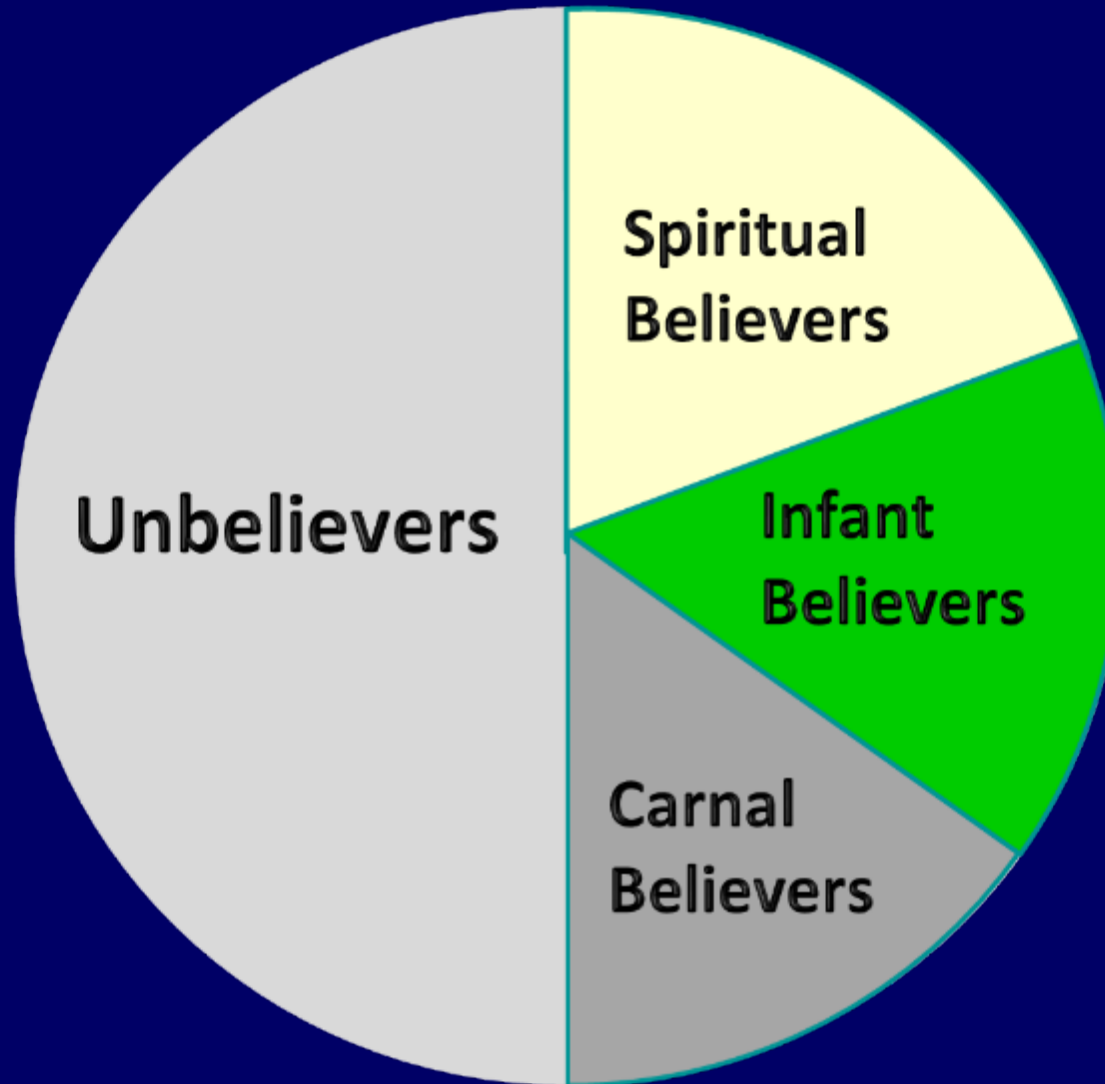


1 Corinthians 3:1-3 (NKJV)

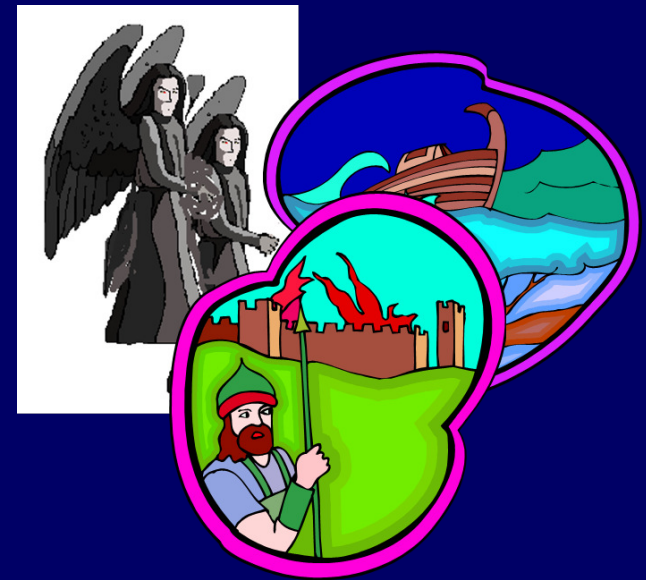

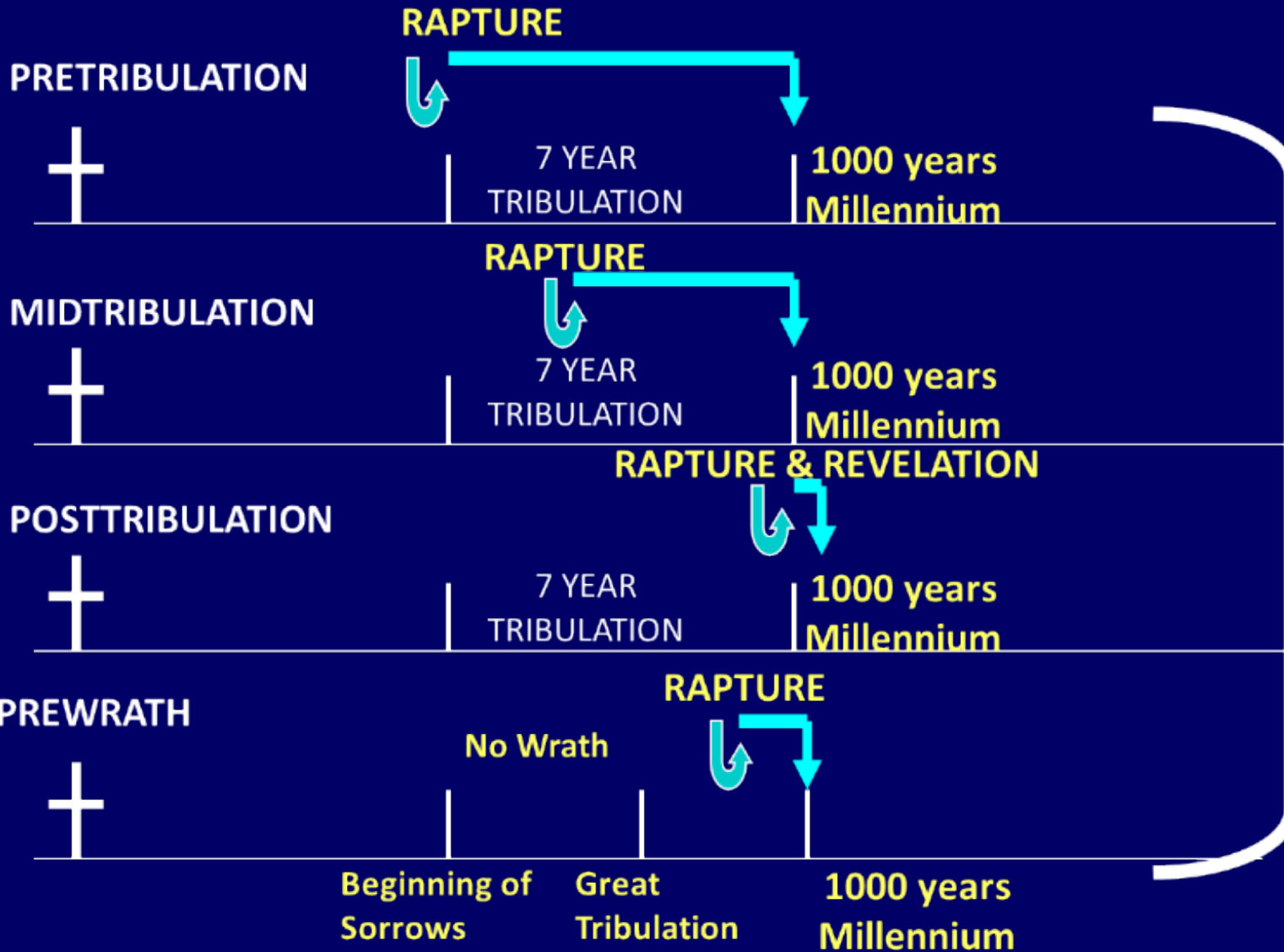


When Will the Rapture Take Place Relative to the Tribulation Period?

Satan's Progressive Defeat

5. Mid point of the Tribulation (Rev 12:9)
6. **Beginning of millennium (Rev 20:2-3)**
7. End of millennium (Rev 20:10)

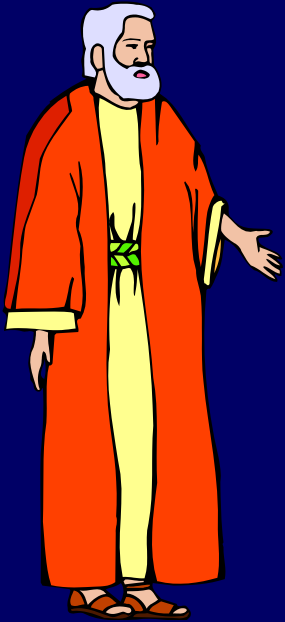
