5	Interpreting handwriting of the wall at Belshazzar's feast	Early 80's

Succession of Gentile Rulers

- 1-4: Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon
- 5: Belshazzar of Babylon
- 6: Darius of Media – Persia
- 7-8: Belshazzar of Babylon
- 9: Darius of Media – Persia
- 10-12: Cyrus of Media – Persia

Daniel 8:20-21 (NASB)

“The ram which you saw with the two horns represents the kings of Media and Persia.²¹ The shaggy goat *represents* the kingdom of Greece, and the large horn that is between his eyes is the first king.”



6 Empires

- Babylon (2:36-38; 7:4) 605-539 BC
- Media-Persia (2:39a; 7:5) 539-331 BC
- Greece (2:39b; 7:6) 331-63 BC
- Rome I (2:40; 7:7a) 63 BC – 70 AD
- Rome II (2:41-43; 7:7b-8) Tribulation
- Kingdom (2:44-45; 7:9-14) After 2nd Coming

6 Empires

- Babylon (2:36-38; 7:4) 605-539 BC
- Media-Persia (2:39a; 7:5) 539-331 BC
- Greece (2:39b; 7:6) 331-63 BC
- Rome I (2:40; 7:7a) 63 BC – 70 AD
- Rome II (2:41-43; 7:7b-8) Tribulation
- Kingdom (2:44-45; 7:9-14) After 2nd Coming

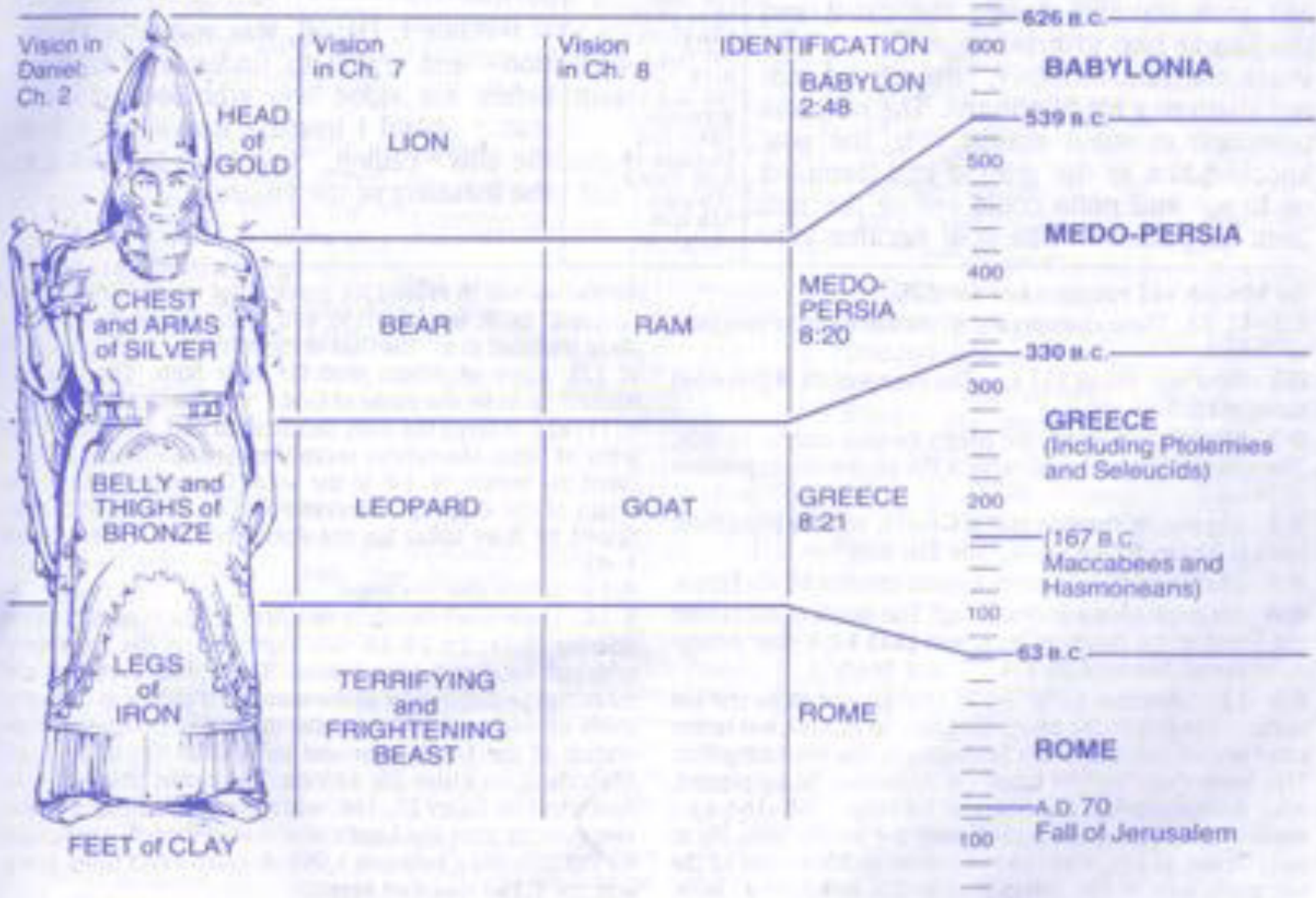

Chronology of Major Empires in Daniel



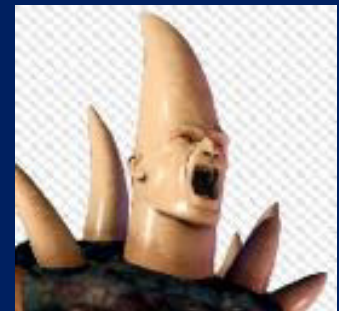

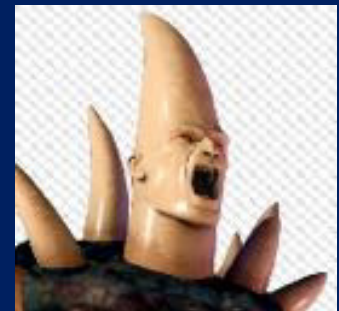

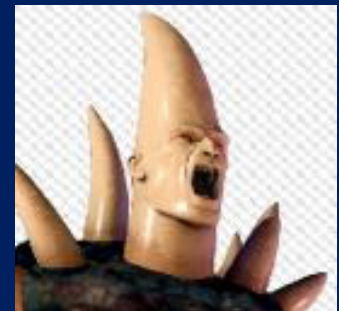

THE 1 HORNED GOAT V. 5-8

(cont'd)

■ (v. 8)

◆ The goat's changing horns

- He magnifies himself (v.8a)
- Alexander's death (v.8b)
- Alexander's empire is divided among his four generals (v.8c)

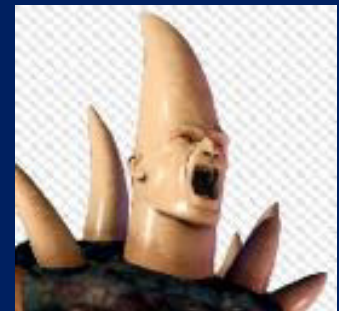
Cassander Macedonia	Ptolemy Egypt

THE RISE OF ANTIOCHUS

- The Seleucid dynasty
- The Seleucid dynasty rules over Syria and Israel
- Antiochus becomes the ruler of the Seleucid dynasty
- Antiochus is the subject of verses 9-14

Ezekiel 5:5

“Thus says the Lord GOD, ‘This is Jerusalem; I have set her at the center of the nations, with lands around her.’”



Ezekiel 38:12

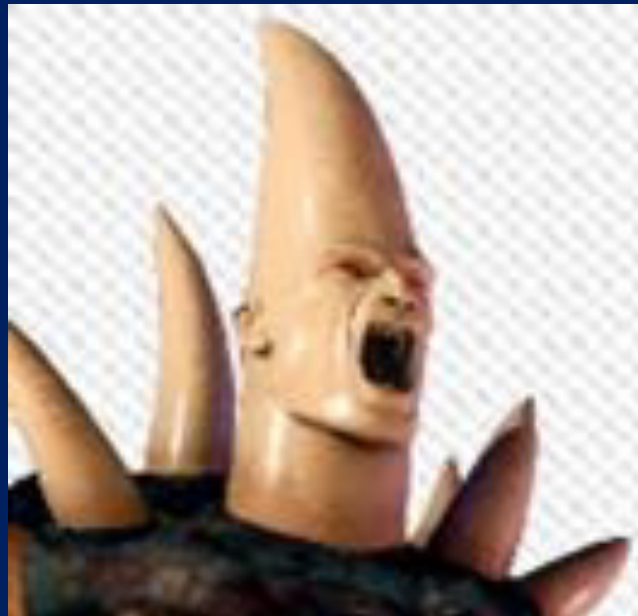
“to capture spoil and to seize plunder, to turn your hand against the waste places which are *now* inhabited, and against the people who are gathered from the nations, who have acquired cattle and goods, who live at the center of the world.”



THE BOASTFUL LITTLE HORN V. 9-14

■ V. 9

- ◆ The conquests of Antiochus
- ◆ Antiochus foreshadows the future Antichrist

THE BOASTFUL LITTLE HORN V. 9-14

■ V. 10

- ◆ Antiochus' persecution of Israel
- ◆ Goal is Hellenization
- ◆ He viewed the Jews as an obstacle to his goal
- ◆ He outlawed the Hebrew scriptures and executed families who observed the Sabbath and circumcision



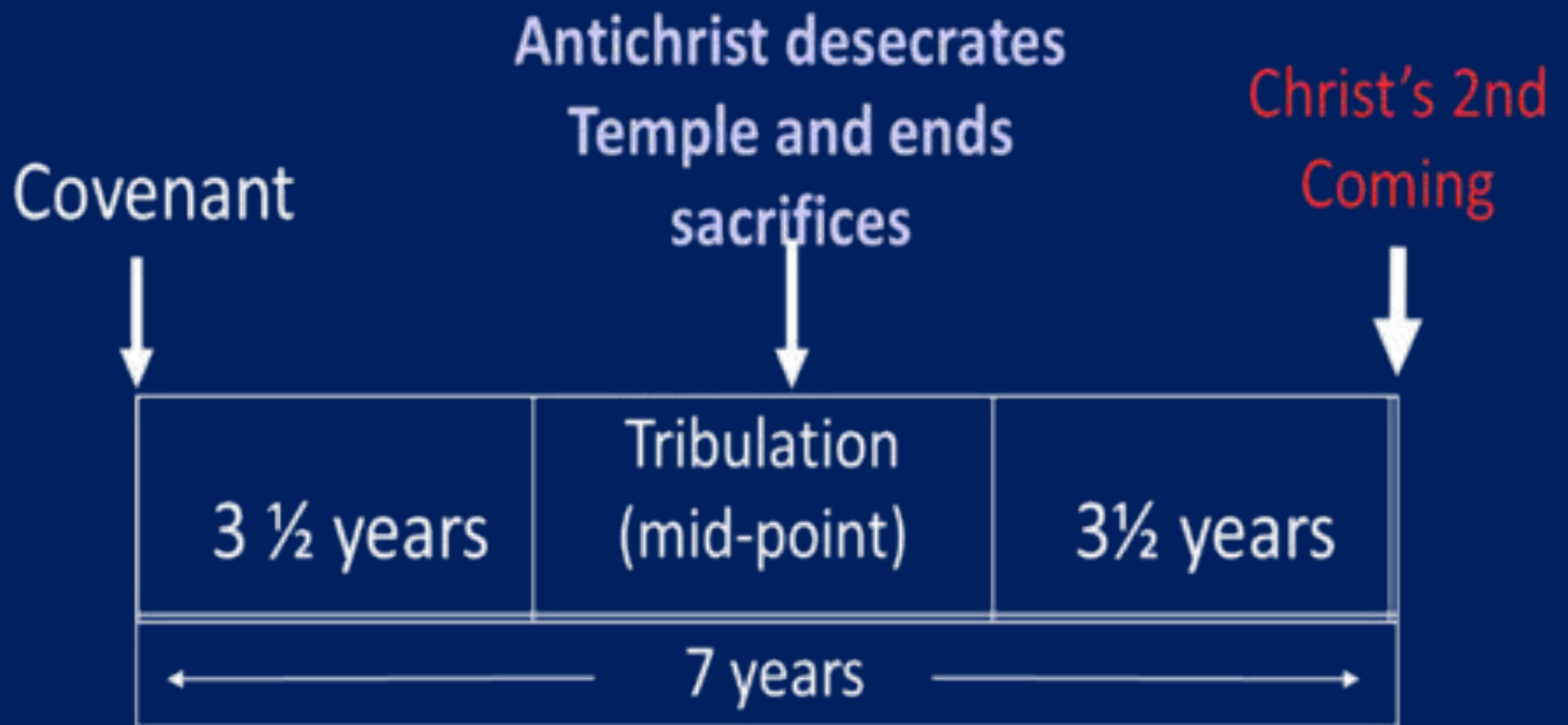
THE BOASTFUL LITTLE HORN V. 9-14

■ V. 11

- ◆ Made himself equal with God
- ◆ Stopped Jewish sacrifices
- ◆ Desecrated the temple (167 BC)
 - Set up an image of Zeus
 - Sacrificed a pig on the altar



DAN 9:27 OVERVIEW OF TRIBULATION PERIOD



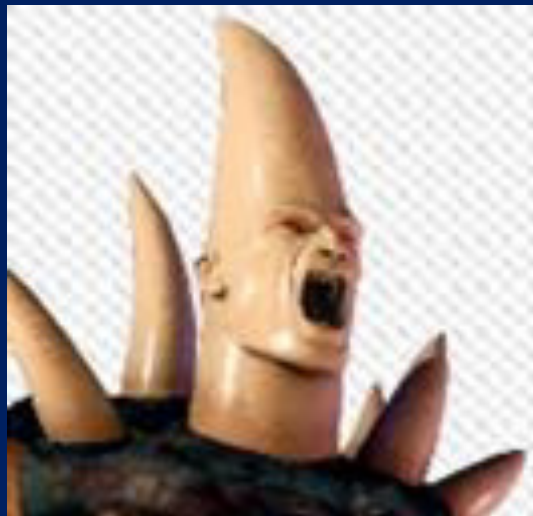
THE BOASTFUL LITTLE HORN V. 9-14

- V. 12
 - ◆ Persecuted Israel
 - ◆ Stopped the sacrifices
 - ◆ Disregarded the truth
 - ◆ Prospered



THE BOASTFUL LITTLE HORN V. 9-14

- Persecuted the Jews
- Desecrated the temple
- Prospered



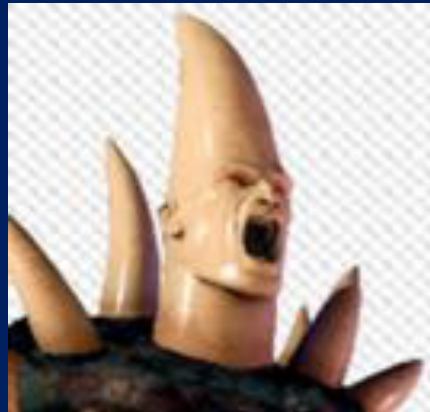
THE BOASTFUL LITTLE HORN V. 9-14

- V. 13
 - ◆ How long will temple desecration last?
- V. 14
 - ◆ 2300 evenings and mornings



THE BOASTFUL LITTLE HORN V. 9-14

- 171 BC-Dec. 25th 165 BC
- = 2300 mornings and evenings
- Daniel predicted these events roughly 400 years in advance
- Argument over the date of Daniel



HANUKKAH

- The Maccabean revolt
- December 25th 165 BC : the temple is liberated and rededicated
- 1 & 2 Maccabees
- The miracle of the lamp oil
- Hanukkah “Feast of Dedication” (festival of lights).
- Christmas / Jewish Holiday
- John 10:22-24

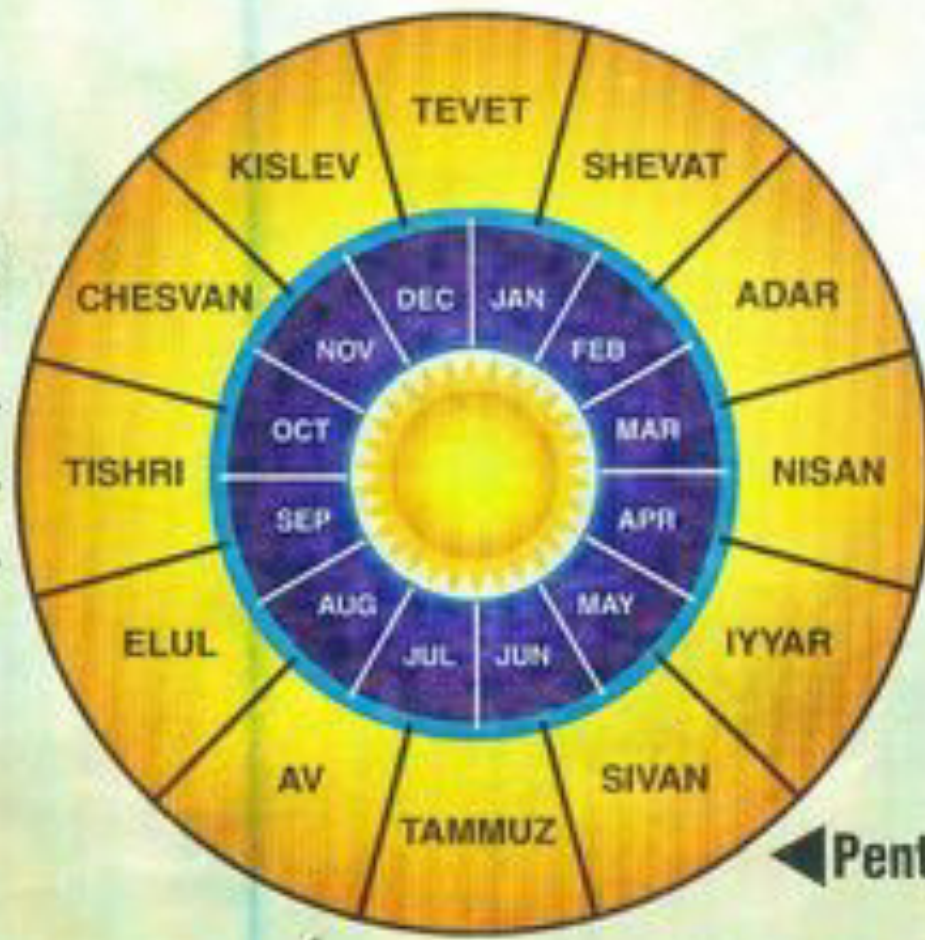

Atonement	Fall	Lev 16	Zech. 12:10
Booths	Fall	Wilderness provision	Zech. 14:16-18

FALL FEASTS

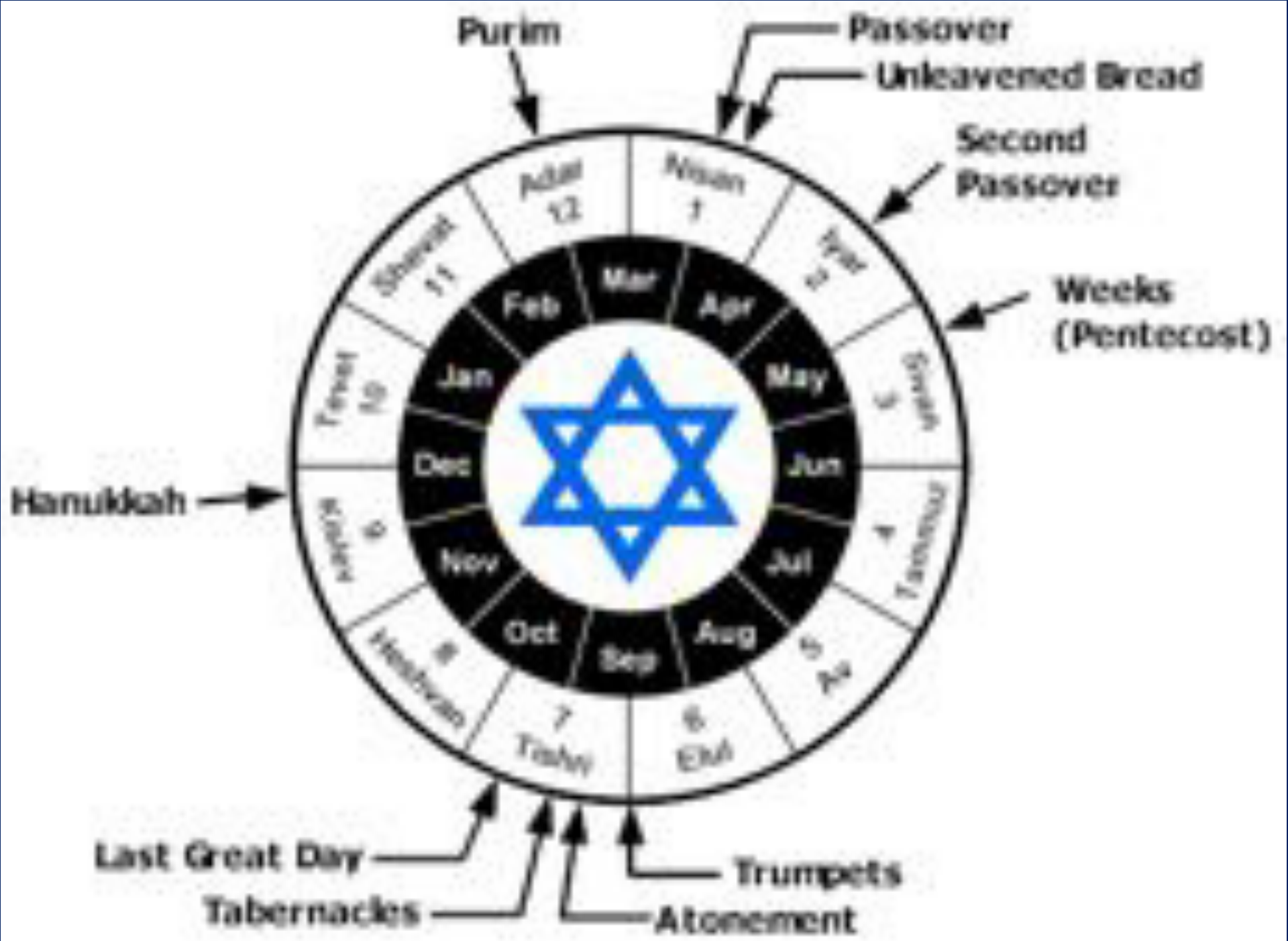
- ▶ **Tabernacles**

INTERPRETATION V.15-25

- No guess work is needed
- V. 15
 - ◆ Daniel seeks an interpretation
- V. 16
 - ◆ A voice tells Gabriel to interpret the vision
- V. 17
 - ◆ “Time of the end” means the end of the third kingdom (Greece) not the end of the age
- V. 18-19
 - ◆ “Time of the end” is the end of Antiochus’ desecration

INTERPRETATION V.15-25

- V. 20
- Ram = Media-Persia



INTERPRETATION V.15-25

■ V. 21

- ◆ Goat = Greece
- ◆ Horn between eyes = Alexander the Great

■ V. 22

- ◆ “Broken horn” = the demise of Alexander the Great
- ◆ “Four Horns” = four generals
- ◆ The divided kingdom was not as strong as Alexander’s kingdom

■ V. 23-35

- ◆ The Activities of Antiochus Epiphanes
- ◆ Foreshadowing of the antichrist

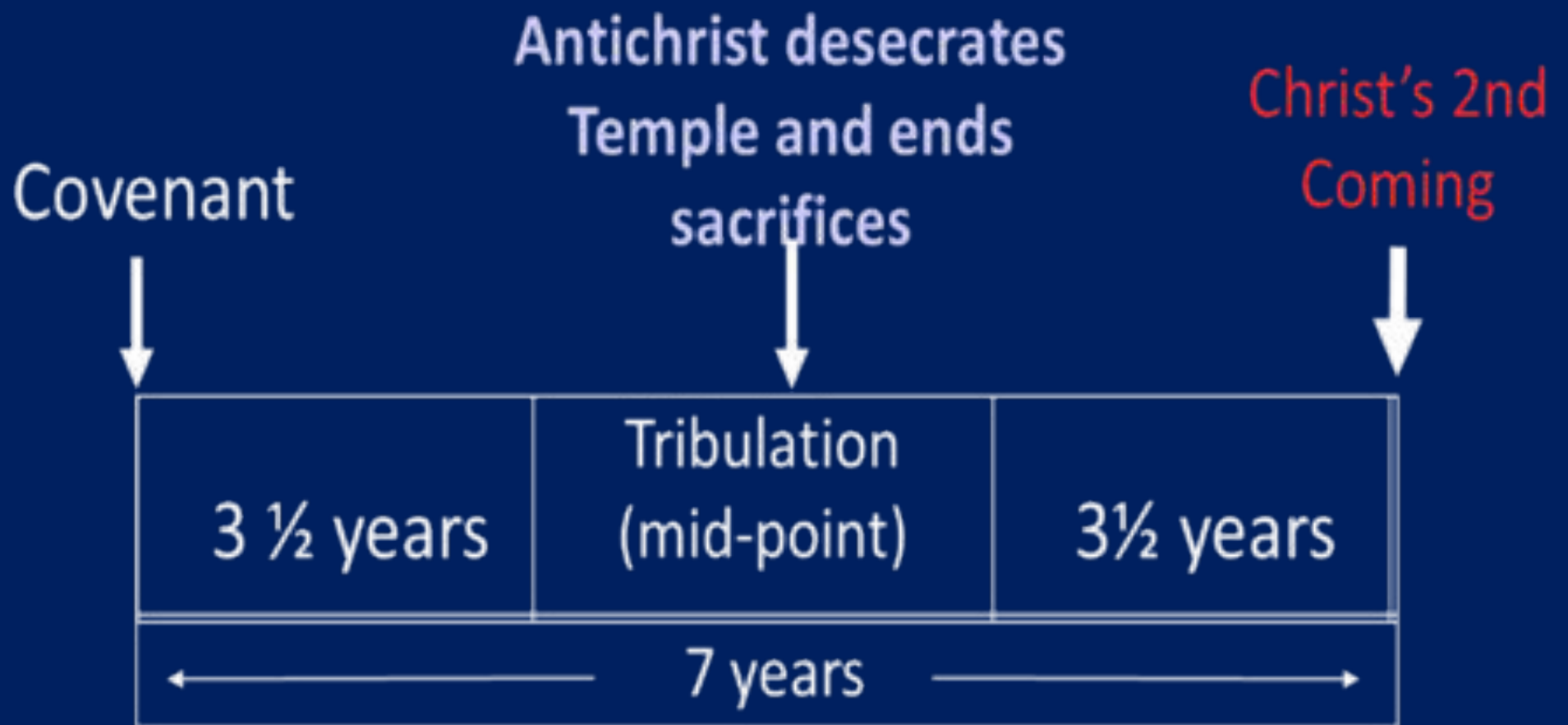

TIME FRAME V.26

■ V. 26

- ◆ True
- ◆ Daniel is told to keep it a secret
- ◆ The vision will not be fulfilled for 386 years
- ◆ Daniel 12:4, 9

Daniel 12:4, 9 (NASB)

“But as for you, Daniel, conceal these words and seal up the book until the end of time; many will go back and forth, and knowledge will increase...Go *your way*, Daniel, for *these* words are concealed and sealed up until the end time.”



Amos 8:12 (NASB)

“People will stagger from sea to sea
And from the north even to the east;
They will go to and fro to seek the
word of the LORD, But they will not
find *it*.”
