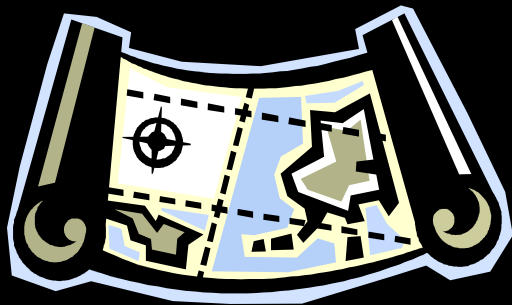

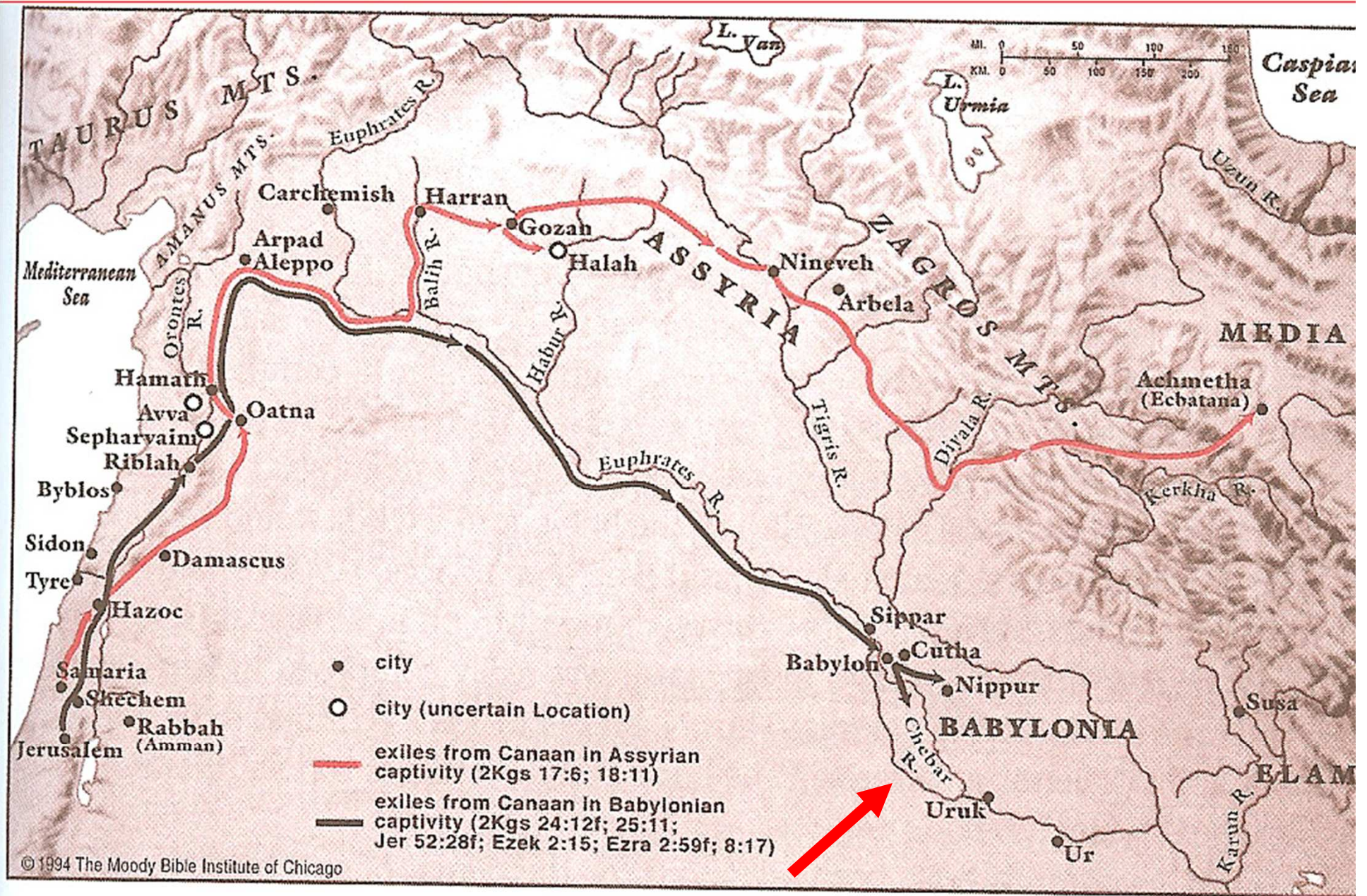

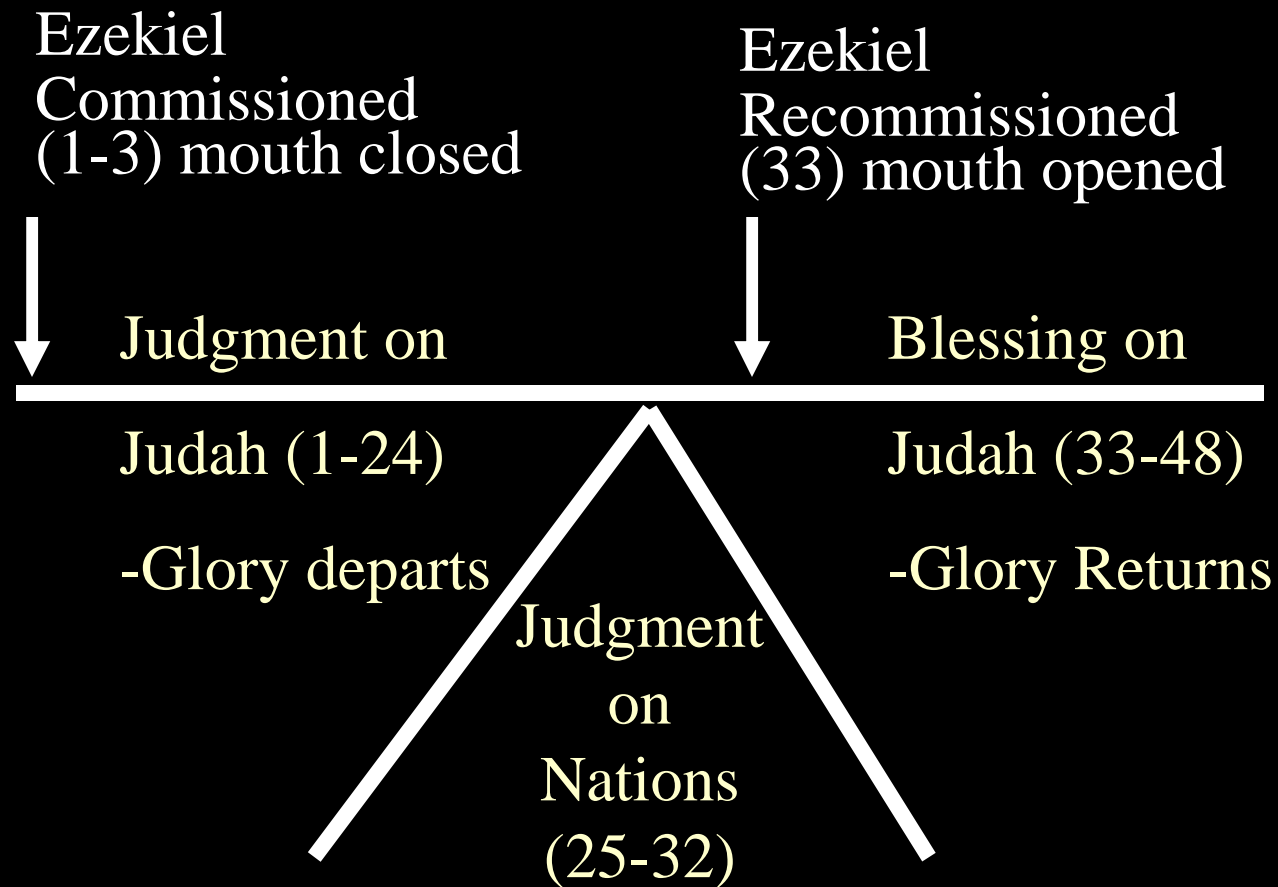
- Division of the kingdom in 931 B.C.

EXILE OF ISRAEL (721 B.C.) AND EXILE OF JUDAH (586 B.C.)

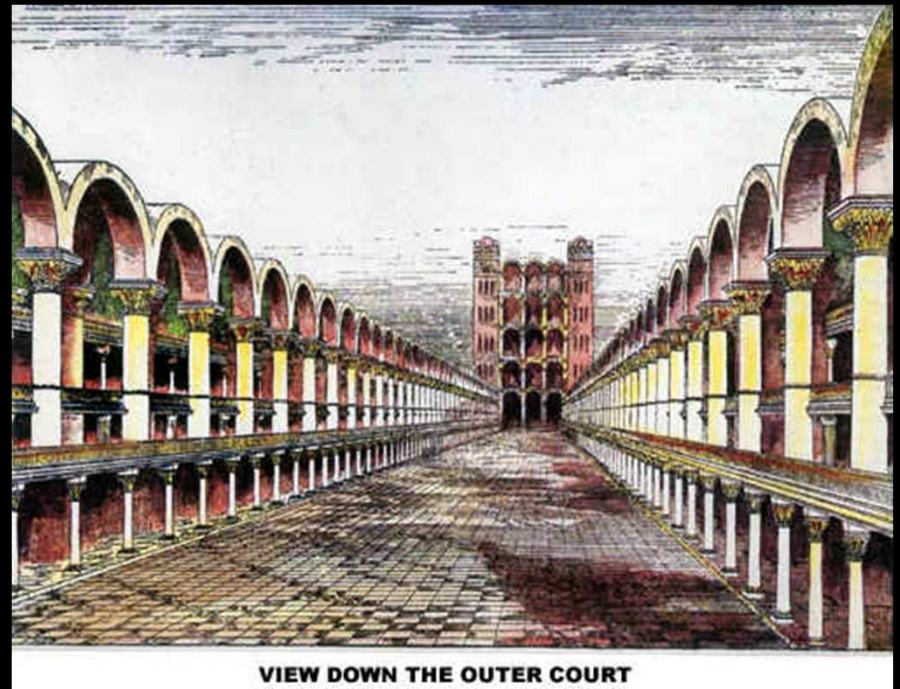

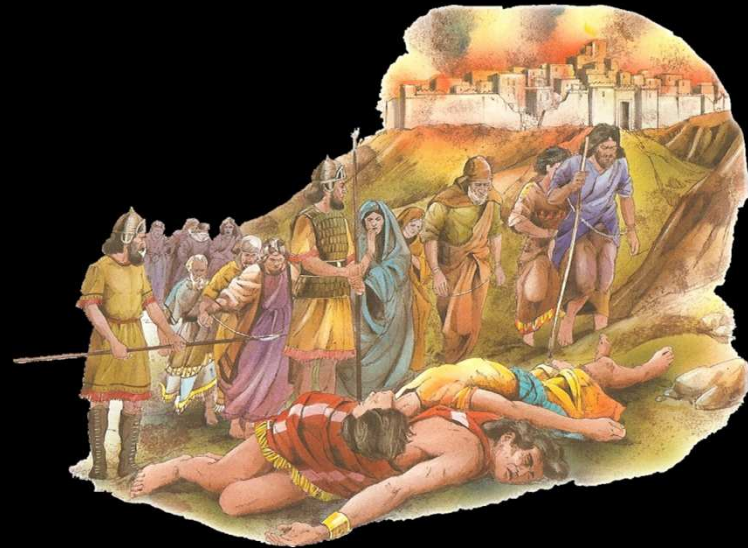

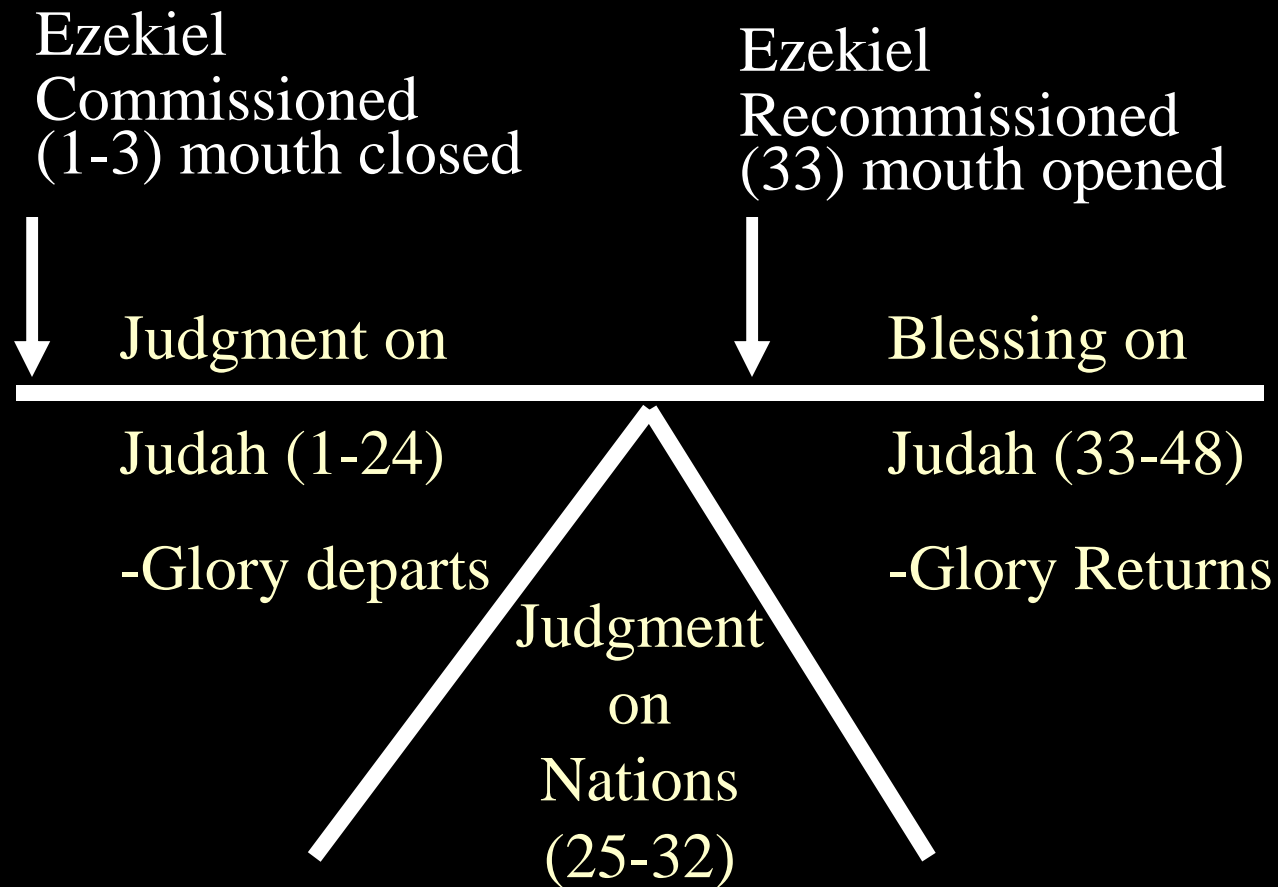

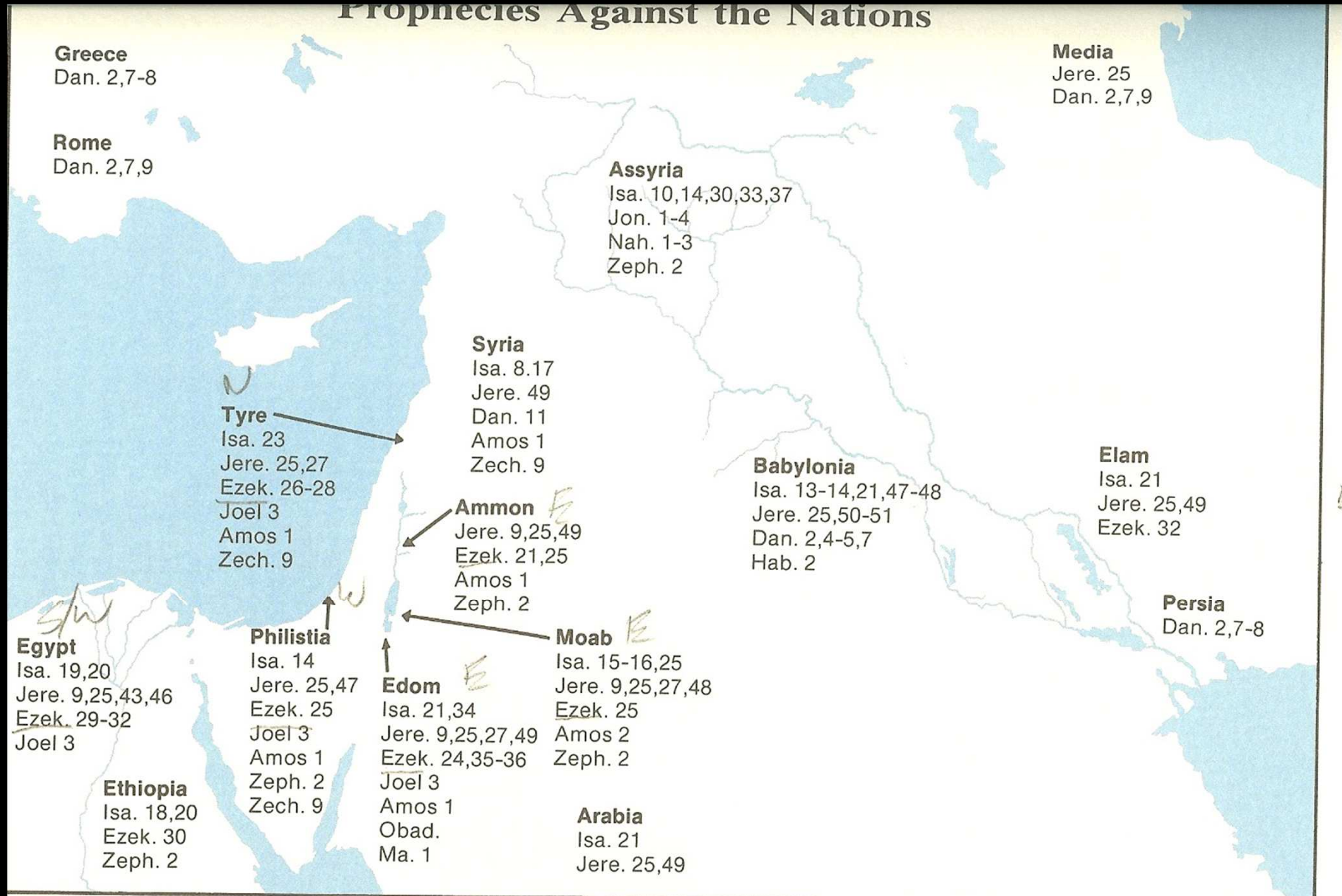

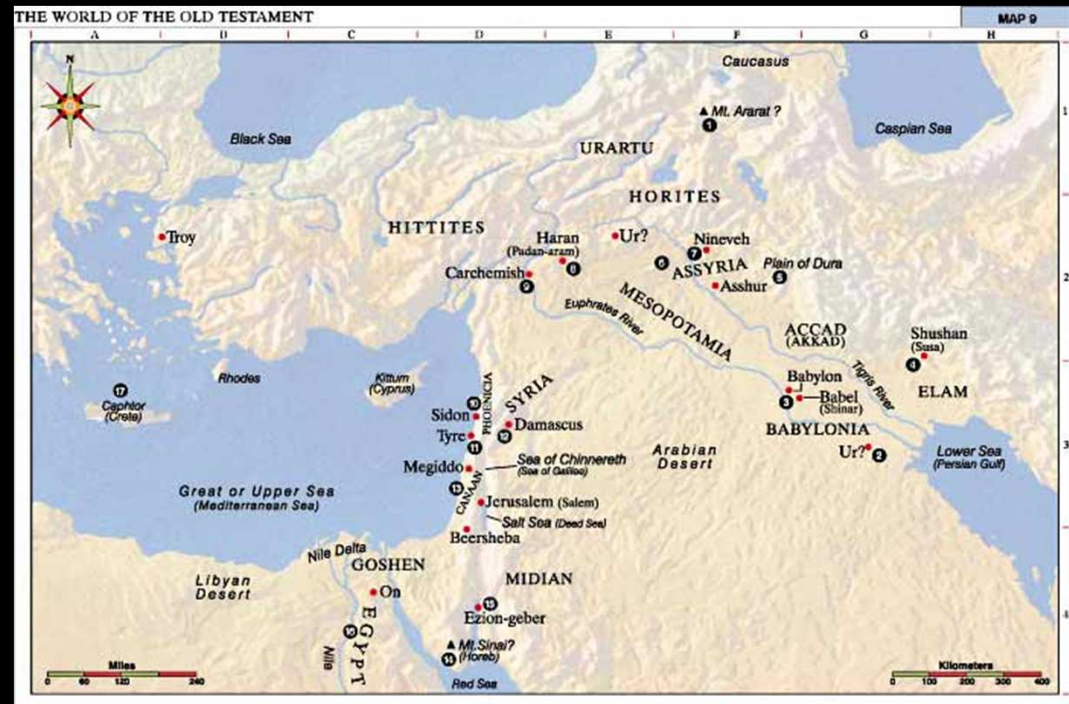

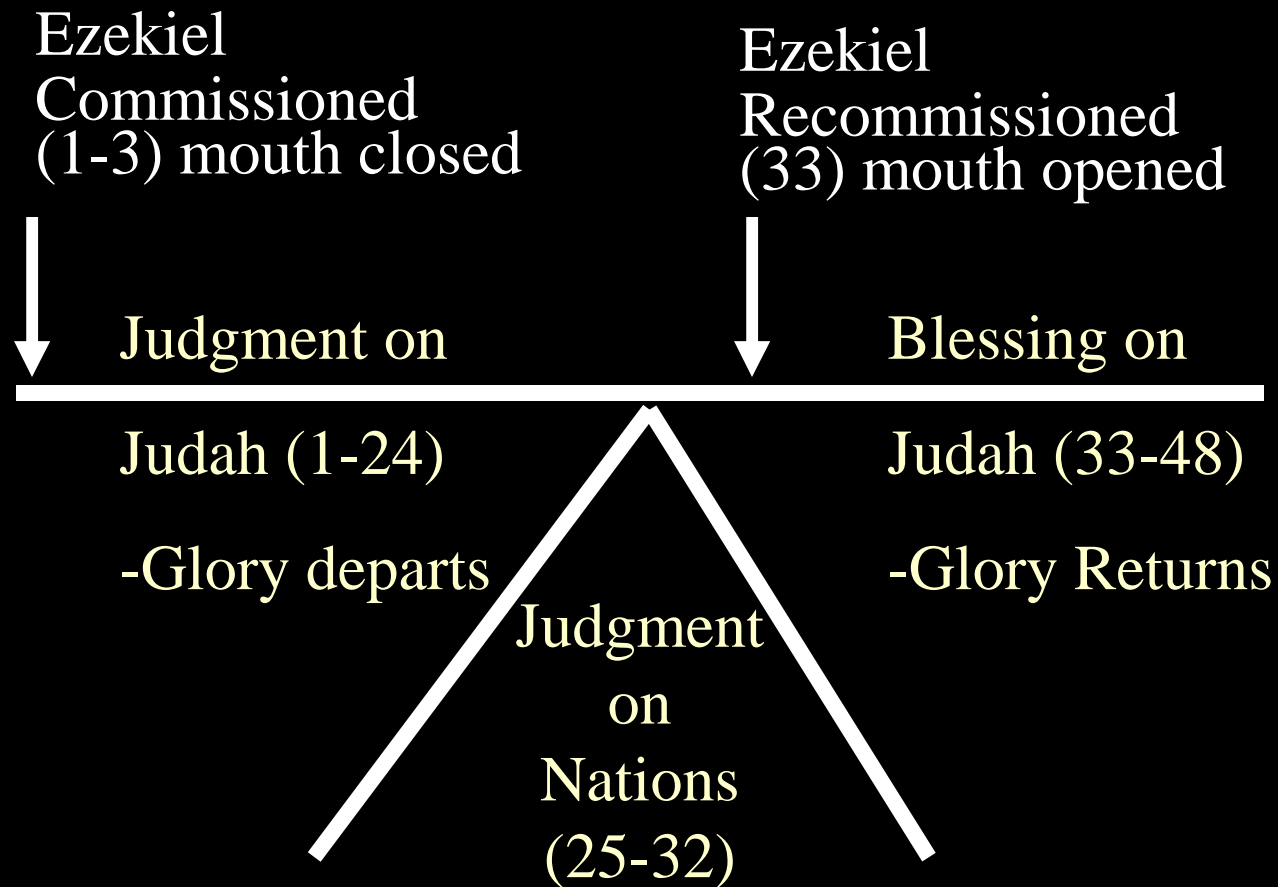

Israel's Two Regatherings

THE PRESENT (FIRST) REGATHERING	THE PERMANENT (SECOND) REGATHERING
Return to part of the land	Return to all the land
Return in unbelief	Return in faith
Restored to the land only	Restored to the land and the Lord
Sets the stage for Tribulation (discipline)	Sets the stage for Millennium (blessing)

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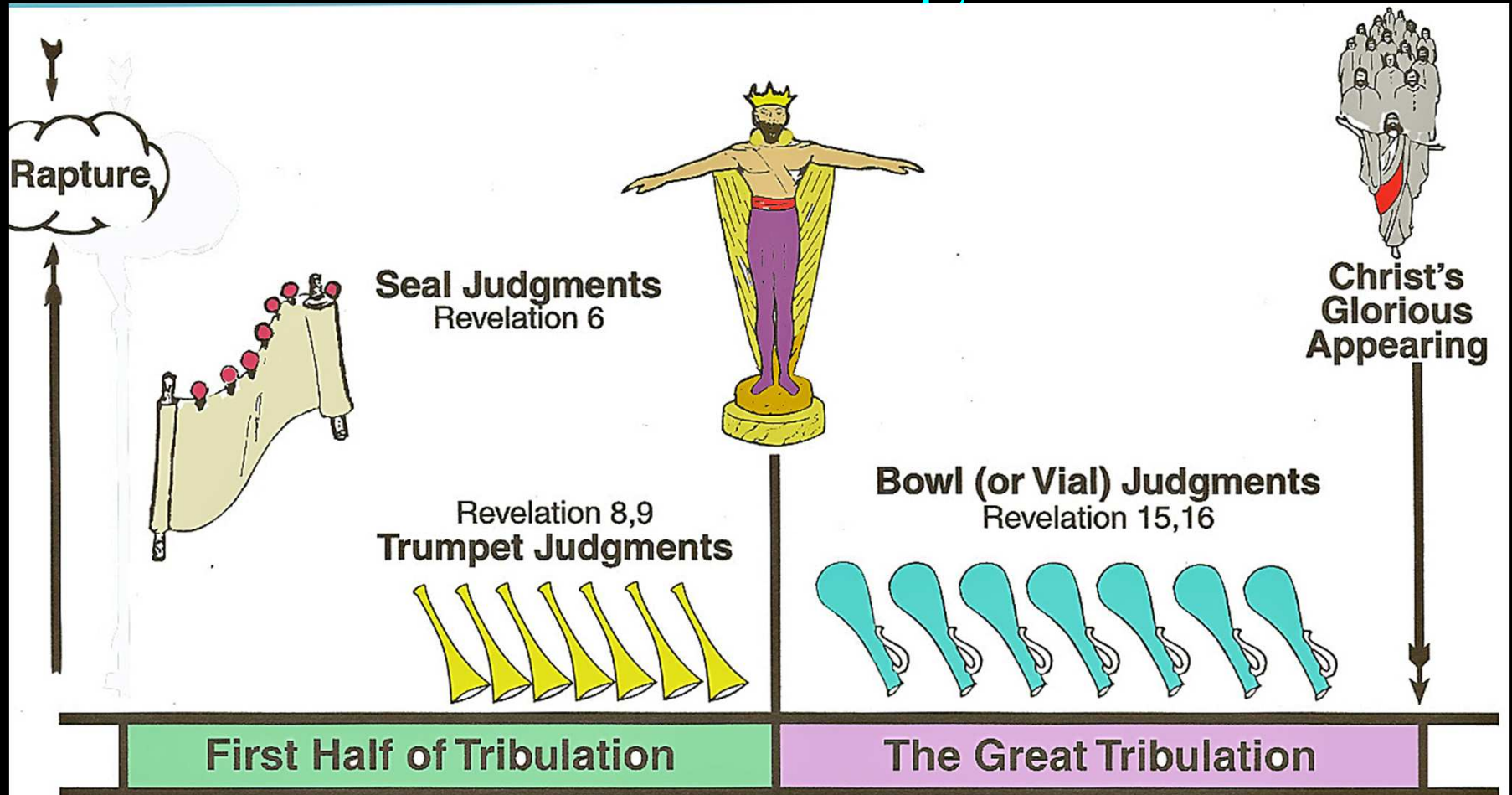

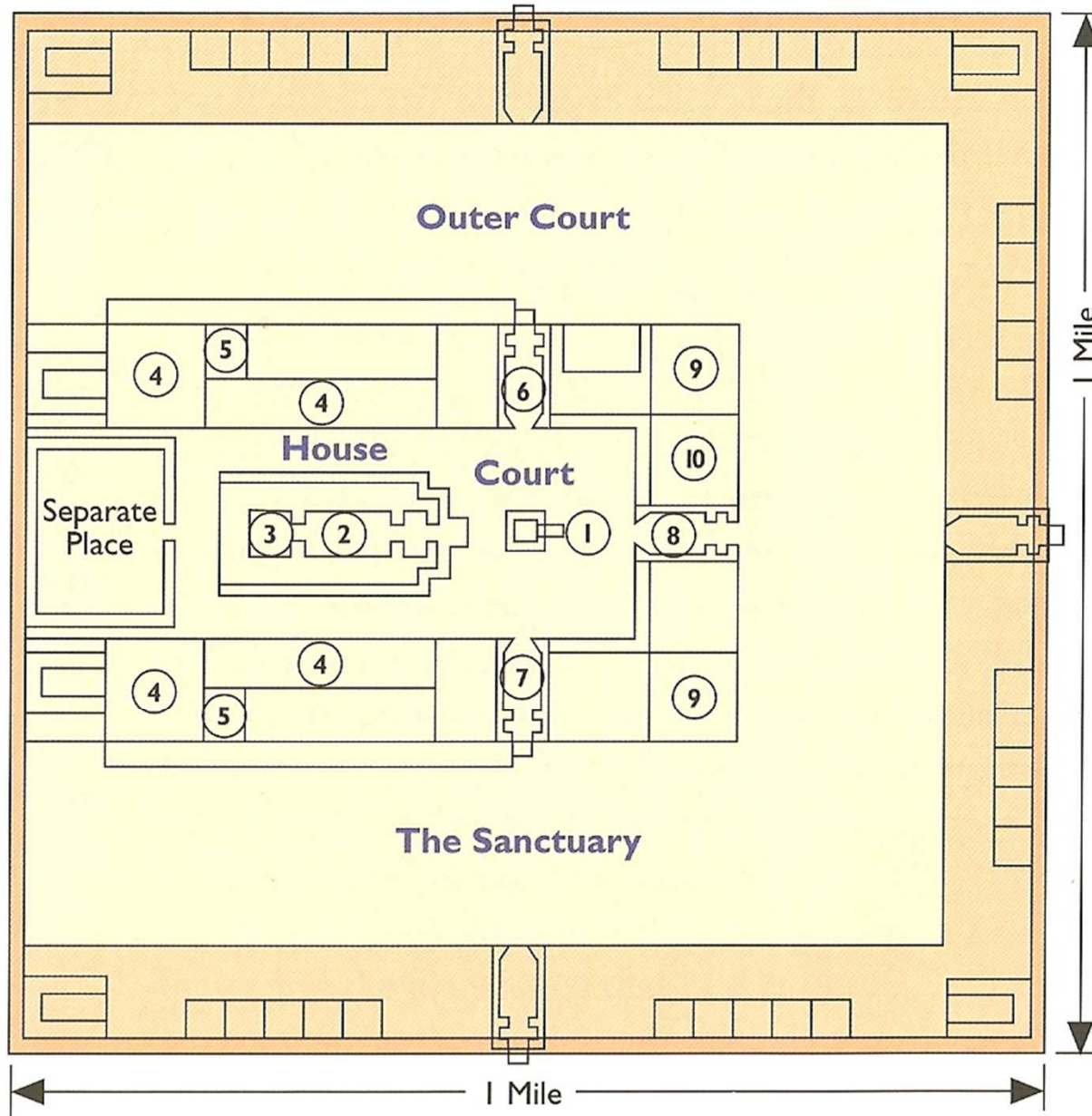

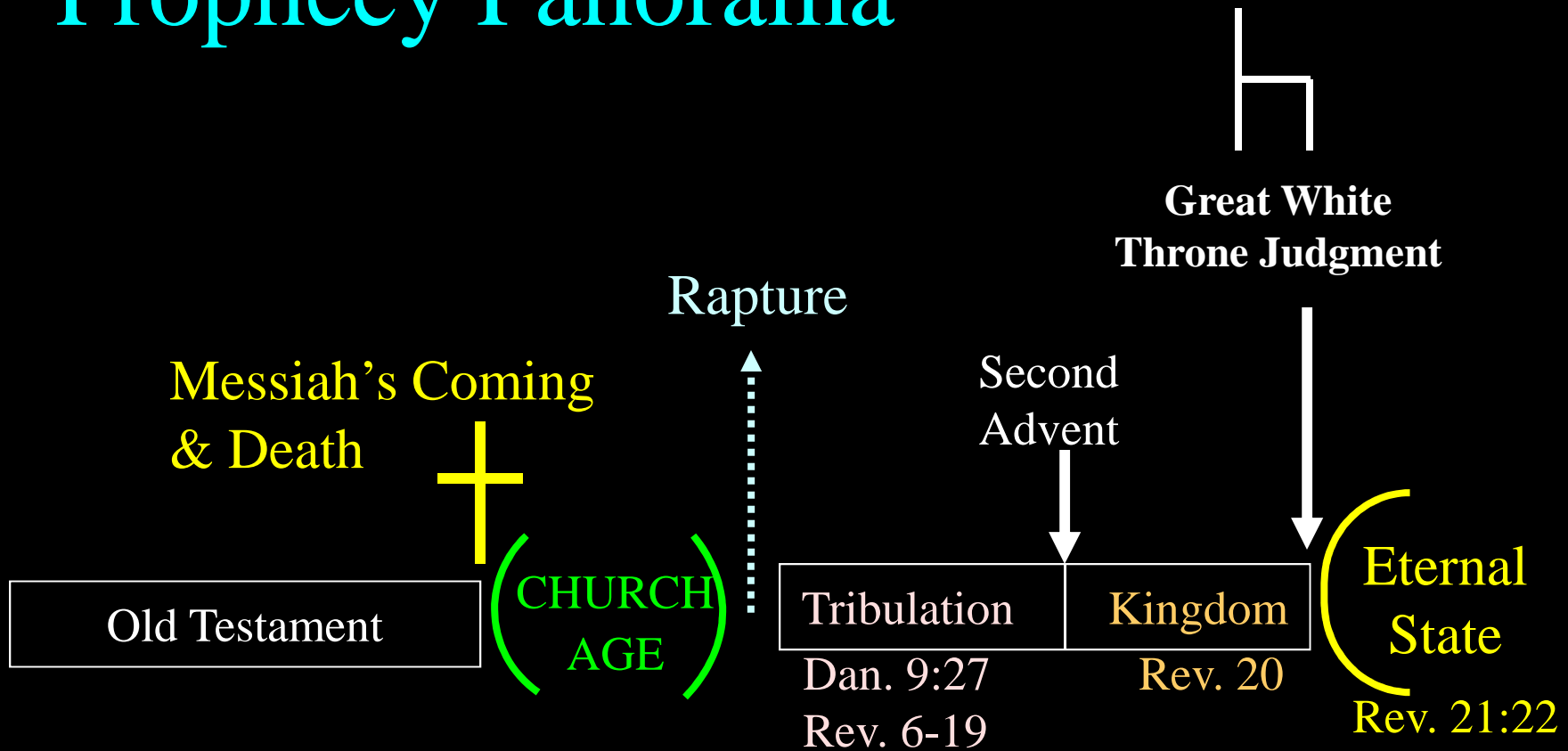
The Millennial Temple

10. Offerings washed



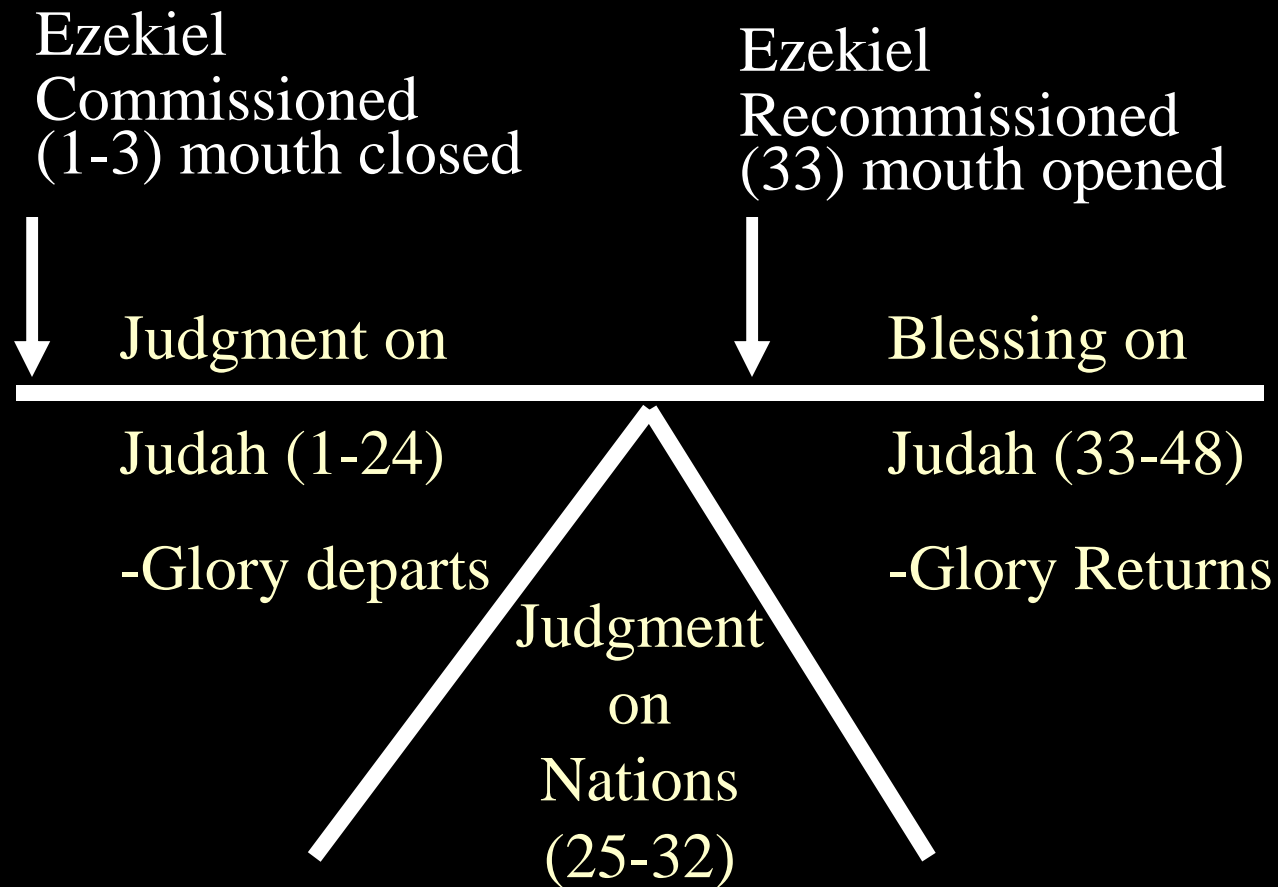
