#### PROMISE TO THE OVERCOMERS



# Progressive Dispensationalism and Revelation 3:21

"One may object that the throne at the right hand of God is not the Davidic throne, which is earthly. The objection might be raised by appealing to a text like **Revelation 3:21**, where Jesus distinguishes between 'my throne,' in which the overcomer will sit, and the Father's throne, on which Jesus currently sits. The argument is made that the throne on which Jesus sits in Acts is the Father's throne, not David's...this throne of the lamb, set next to the Father, is alluded to again in **Revelation 22:1**. This is the same throne that Jesus occupies in the consummation! He exercises Davidic rule now even as he will exercises it then."






### **Genesis** 11:1-4

### Larkin, The Book of Revelation, 151.

"The river Euphrates, on which the city of Babylon was built, was one of the four branches into which the river that flowed through the Garden of Eden was divided, and Satan doubtless chose the site of Babylon as his headquarters from which to sally forth to tempt Adam and Eve. It was doubtless here that the Antediluvian apostasy had its source that ended in the flood. To this centre the 'forces of Evil' gravitated after the Flood, and 'Babel' was the result. This was the origin of the nations, but the nations were not scattered abroad over the earth until Satan had implanted in them the "Virus" of a doctrine that has been the source of every false religion the world has ever


